


Release of Kader Siddiqui demanded

Tk 39 cr scheme for Patenga dam to protect EPZ prepared

The Water Development Board (WDB) has prepared a Taka 39 crore longterm scheme for reconstruction of Patenga embankment, vital for protecting the entire industrial zone of Patenga including Chittagong Export Processing Zone, reports BSS.

The scheme, a waiting approval of the relevant authority, will be executed in October or November next.

15.42 km of the 18.68 km long and 24 feet high Patenga embankment was washed away by April 29 tidal surge, exposing scores of industries and several coastal villages to tidal bore. The embankment needs immediate reconstruction for rehabilitation of several thousand villagers, agriculture and protecting the industrial belt. But no work can not be undertaken immediately because of incessant rains, said the Chief

A total of 321 metric tons of wheat has been allocated for this purpose and the reconstruction work is going on slowly because of intermittent heavy rains.

The WDB has also undertaken reconstruction of 6.03 km damaged embankment on an emergency basis to save the Chittagong Export Processing Zone (EPZ) from the onslaught of tidal surge, a total of 278 tonnes of wheat has been allocated under food for work for this purpose.
