**Darul Ahsan Varsity to be set up in Dhaka**

The setting up of Darul Ahsan University in Dhaka is obviously an encouraging initiative sponsored by the founders with a view to revolutionizing the system of education in Bangladesh. Al-Quran has revealed enormous sources of knowledge which needs proper utilisation for the development of science and technology and natural resources, says a Press release.

This was observed by the Iranian Ambassador during his visit to the Institute of Higher Islamic Learning which is the core Faculty of Darul Ihsan University functioning from 1989 in Dhaka.

The Cultural Attache of Iranian Embassy and the Director Iranian Cultural Centre accompanied the Iranian Ambassador during his visit to the Institute.

He further said that Al-Quran stands out as the Divine source of Islam providing solution to social, Political and economic problems of human society.

The Ambassador gave a brief outline of the Iranian Revolution saying the process of Islamisation started with the victory of peoples revolution and has now maintained a steady

advance. It takes years of struggle for transforming the system of education by introducing the concept Islamic way of life in place of secular concept now prevalent in modern education.

**Dateline Chittagong****Floods worsen Teknaf, Cox's Bazar's situation**

The Chairman of the Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) Major General (Rtd) A M Abdul Huq, said in Dhaka Wednesday that the situation in the cyclone affected areas of Cox's Bazar, Teknaf and Chakoria suddenly worsened due to heavy rains and the resultant floods, reports BSS.

As the situation was returning to normalcy the floods caused by the heavy rains locally and the on-rush of waters from the upper regions exacerbated the sufferings of the people, General Huq said on return from a three-day visit to the cyclone affected areas of Chittagong and Cox's Bazar.
