

8 Islamic centres to be built in cyclone-battered areas

Muslim Aid, a UK based organisation will set up eight Islamic centres in cyclone hit areas of the country.

Representatives of Muslim Aid (UK) Suleman Yousuf Tutla and Golam Ahmed Manayar told this Thursday at a press conference at Jatiya Press

They said these centres will teach Islamic education in a planned way.

The construction work of two centres has already been started in Chittagong cyclonebattered areas, they added.

With the assistance of Islamic Centre, Bangladesh. the Muslim Aid will also establish 200 educational institutions including madrasas and mosques in the affected upaziias and districts, they said, adding a total of 50 thousand pound equivalent to Taka 28 lakhs will be needed for the programme.

Referring to their visit to the affected areas, representatives of the Aid said that they distributed 150 tons goods including blanket, children's clothes and food and Taka six thousand in cash among the distressed people.

The representatives also informed that an elaborate programme including rehabilitation activities would be taken up by the Muslim Aid (UK) on the basis of their report to be submitted to the authorities.
