Slums in the city are built around the power structure of "mathars", "mastans" and political workers thriving on the inmates' labour. reports UNB.

This was revealed in a sample survey of BIDS (Bangladesh Institute of Development Studies) placed today in the concluding session of a twoday workshop.

The squatters are always liable to satisfy this parasitic circle by rendering both labour and part of their hardearned income, found Dr Pratima Paul Majumder in her survey carried out in the Agargaon slum, the largest in the metropolis.

If the squatting people fail to satisfy the 'patrons', their tenancy is threatened, according to Pratima's find presented at the BIDSsponsored workshop on "Urbanization and Urban

Poor." At the insinuation of these power-wielders, drug and liquir consumption among the squatters increases. Besides, according to the survey, they grab most of the government and NGO grants supposed to be distributed among the under-

Inqilab withdraws writ petition

court today. Najmul Hasan appeared for Ingilab Enterprise and Publications Limited, Mr Zainul Abedin for the rest of the petitioners, while Mr AR Yusuf with Sk Habib-ul-Alam, appeared for the Journalists Newspaper Press Workers and Employees Federations. Syed JR Modasser Hossain, Deputy Attorney General appeared for the government.

RAJSHAHI, July 28: The regional poultry farm of Rajshahi has earned a profit of Taka 7 lakh 69 thousand during 1990-91 fiscal year, reports BSS. This profit was earned by

the farm for the first item since its installation in 1986. Covering an area of 15 acres the farm has about 18 thousand five hundred poultry

worth about Taka 12 lakh. During the last fiscal year Taka 22 lakh 46 thousand was spent in the farm on account of pay and salary of the staff, food of poultry and other ex-
