Inadequate drainage, sanitation causes outbreak of diarrhoea

A two-day workshop on "18-district towns water supply, sanitation and drainage project" began at the National Institute of Local Government (NILG) in Dhaka Wednesday, reports BSS.

LORD and Cooperatives Minister Abdus Salam Talukder inaugurated the workshop.

Presided over by Secretary of the Local Government Division Mushfiqur Rahman, the inaugural session was addressed, among others, by the Dutch Ambassador to Bangladesh H. Gajentaan, Programme Coordinator of Dutch assisted projects CA Vulto and Chief Engineer of the Department of Public Health Engineering M. A. Karim.

The project being implemented under the Netherlands Development Cooperation Programme, aims at the betterment of health status of people through promotion of water supply, sanitation and drainage in the concerned district towns. The project is scheduled to be completed in three phases by the year 1995.

In his inaugural address, the LORD and Cooperatives Minister said that a sustainable water supply, sanitation and drainage system was required in the country to improve the general health status of the population through prevention of water-borne diseases.

Abdus Salam Talukder said the conventional approach of sole emphasis on the need for improving water supply system for preventing the occurrence of diarrhoeal diseases has proved inadequate.

It has now become imperative to equally focus on promotion of sanitation and drainage systems as low growth in these two sectors tend to strengthen the vehicles of spreading diarrhoeal diseases, he added.

Talukder said the participation and involvement of the people's representatives and women in the implementation of the water supply, sanitation and drainage project for district towns would help attain a sustainable growth in the country's public health sector. He said it should be kept in mind that no development endeavours would attain success without the wilful and active participation and cooperation of the people.

The workshop is participated by Chairmen and Women Commissioners of the concerned pourashabas, officials of the department of Public Health Engineering and representatives of donor agencies.

Tk 30cr for city roads, drainage systems

The Mayor of Dhaka City Corporation Mirza Abbas Wednesday said City Corporation would start the reconstruction works of damaged roads and drainage system of the city at a cost of Taka 30 crore after the rainy season, reports BSS.

The Mayor said this while addressing an anti-terrorist rally organised by Tejgaon Union of Jatiyatabadi Jubadal at Kwan Bazar in the city.

The Mayor called upon all political parties, professionals and intellectuals of the country to come forward in wiping out violence and terrorism.

Abbas said it was not possible on the part of newly elected government alone to stop violence. "All sections of people should cooperate with the government in this respect," he added.

The Mayor also urged the city people to cooperate with different activities of the City Corporation.

KHULNA, Aug 14 : Education and Cultural Affairs Minister Prof. A. Q. M. Badruddoza Chowdhury has expressed the firm determination of the government to bring back congenial atmosphere stopping terrorism on the campuses, reports BSS.
