Inadequate drainage, sanitation causes outbreak of diarrhoea

A two-day workshop on "18-district towns water supply, sanitation and drainage project" began at the National Institute of Local Government (NILG) in Dhaka Wednesday, reports BSS.

LORD and Cooperatives Minister Abdus Salam Talukder inaugurated the workshop.

Presided over by Secretary of the Local Government Division Moshfiqur Rahman, the inaugural session was addressed, among others, by the Dutch Ambassador to Bangladesh H. Gajentaan, Programme Coordinator of Dutch assisted projects CA Vullo and Chief Engineer of the Department of Public Health Engineering M A Karim.

The project being implemented under the Netherland Lands-Bangladesh Development Cooperation

Programme, aims at the betterment of health status of people through promotion of water supply, sanitation and drainage in the concerned districts.

The project is scheduled to be completed in three phases by the year 1995.
