GEORGETOWN, Aug 20: The government of Guyana Monday signed an agreement with two private firms to develop a major gold mining complex, reports AFP.

Extending over a 42square-kilometer area (16square-mile), the center registered under the name Omai Gold Mines Limited is expected to produce 255,000 ounces of gold annually, officials said.

Production at the 170-million Dollar facility is scheduled to begin by March 1993, they added.

The agreement was signed by officials of the Guyana Natural Resources Agency and the Canadian companies Cambior and Golden Star Resources.

Import letters of credit (LCs), valued Taka 114.51 billion, were opened for commodities and industrial raw

materials under the commercial import policy in fiscal 1990-91, according to the latest Bangladesh Bank figures. Of this amount, import LCs worth Tk 964.05 cr (9.46 billion) were opened in the closing month of the year. Import

operations covered LCs, opened under loans, credits, grants, barter, Special Trading Arrangements (STAs), Wage Earners Scheme (WES), Secondary Exchange Market (SEM) and Cash.

Bangladesh Bank figures showed the imports against LC openings, worth Tk 46.41 billion, were in the pipeline on June 30, 1991. The pipeline position indicated the value of importable commodities and industrial raw materials for which the LCs were opened but consignments were still to arrive.

The pipeline position for some major items at the close of fiscal 1990-91 was as follows: wheat - Tk. 178.47 cr, milk food - Tk 70.73 cr, refined crude oil - Tk 30.57 cr, crude edible oil - Tk 40.97 cr, otl or rape seed - Tk 47.92 cr;

Bank of Tokyo suspends Rouble dealing

TOKYO, Aug 20: Bank of Tokyo Ltd has suspended trading in the Soviet Rouble following the replacement of Soviet President Mikhail Gorbachev by hardline Vice-President Gennady Yanayev, a bank official said Tuesday, reports AFP.

The officials said the Bank's Rouble-Yen transactions were "quite small" as most trade and investment deals were conducted on a Ruble-Dollar basis.

The Bank Japan's biggest foreign exchange dealer, had been providing telegraphic transfer rates as well as buying and selling rates for the Rouble against the Japanese currency.

The other items like paper, paper board, tyre and tubes, spare parts of commercial and industrial motor vehicles and bi-cycles, watches, parts and components, tractors and trailors, power tillers, irrigation, marine and other transportable engines, non-ferrous metal, other machinery, iron and steel products, G P sheet, limestone, ball bearing, G P Sheet, hardcoke, coal, spices, onion, pulses, coconut oil, dry and fresh fruits, salt and sugar accounted for the rest of LCs.

Meanwhile, the highest amount LCs at Th 2204.77 cr in 1990-91 was opened for textile fabrics under back-toback arrangements. LCs for POL, both crude and refined, totalled Tk 1514.96 cr, in last fiscal year.
