1100 lathyritis patients now forced to beg Hundreds of lathyritis patients in the district denied proper treatment and rehabilitation, have now compelled to begging for bare survival, reports UNB. In almost every village of Chapainawabganj district, they are always found moving door to door for alms. A hospital planned to be established here for treatment and rehabilitation of the patients still remains bound by the red-tape, it was alleged. Lathyritis broke out in an epidemic form in several parts of the country including Chapainawabganj, soon after independence. Statistical data shows the number of lathyritis patients only in Shibganj, Bohaliahat, Gomostapur, Nachol and Sadar Upazilas of the district almost reached 1100. The government carried out a survey on the outbreak of disease and a foreign NGO helped a few projects to help combat lathyritis in this area. But the project had been abandoned following allegations of misappropriation of funds and corruption. Another project entitled "Self Development" under which foodgrains used to be distributed to the suffering kids and mothers also wound up due to corrupt practices of a local Chairman and members. Local leaders and elite demanded an extensive survey to identify genuine lathyritis patients and ensure proper treatment and rehabilitation of them. They suggested setting up of small and cottage industries for these patients to earn their bread.

12th Amendment Bill a conspiracy, says Sirajul Hossain By Staff Correspondent Acting President of Jatiya Krishak Party and a former minister Sirajul Hussain Khan termed the 12th Constitution Amendment Bill as a conspiracy against the country and its people. He called upon the people to reject the bill by casting 'no' vote in the referendum of September 15. In a statement Wednesday, Sirajul Hussain Khan said that the proposed 12th Amendment Bill incorporates some undemocratic provisions like absolute power for the Prime Minister. He apprehended that an autocratic rule would be established if the Amendment Bill was approved by the referendum. Khan maintained absolute parliamentary or presidential system gives birth to autocracy. He suggested that a mixed system of parliamentary and presidential form of government should be adopted which would establish democracy on a strong footing. The head of the government can never be an autocrat under this mixed system, he added. Chittagong Metropolitan Police detectives rounded up 38 persons and recovered one country made gun, one pipegun and seven cartridges from different areas of the city Wednesday. According to a police press release, the arrest included absconders, illegal arm holders and hijackers.

'Vested group trying to misuse students' Agriculture, Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control Minister M Majid-ul-Haq Wednesday said that the present government had given priority on education for overall development of the country, reports BSS. He said maximum allocation had been provided in education sector in the current national budget. The minister was addressing a students gathering organised by Mir Mosharraf Hossain Hall Students' Union of Jahangirnagar University at Savar. Majid-ul-Haq said the primary duty of the students was to receive proper education and make themselves worthy citizens of the country. He expressed deep concern over terrorism and lawlessness created by some miscreants in a number of educational institutions. He said a handful of vested interests were trying to misuse a section of the students to stop the present pace of development in the country.
