Normalcy returns to Salimullah Medical College Hòspital





12th Amendment Bill a conspiracy, says Sirajul

Krishak Party and a former minister Sirajul Hussain Khan termed the 12th Constitution Amendment Bill as a conspiracy against the country and its people. He called upon the people to reject the bill by casting 'no' vote in the referendum of September 15.

Khan criticised the political parties which took initiative jointly to pass the 12th Amendment Bill in the Parliament. He further said that these parties were in power or shared power in the past and during their rule over two hundred billionaires were created in this country.

He urged the people to unite against the 12th Amendment Bill.
