He also underlined the importance of attaining an integrated global approach in building roads and highways to the common benefit of the people of the world at large.

The minister was addressing the 19th World Road Congress in Marrakesh, Morocco on Monday last.

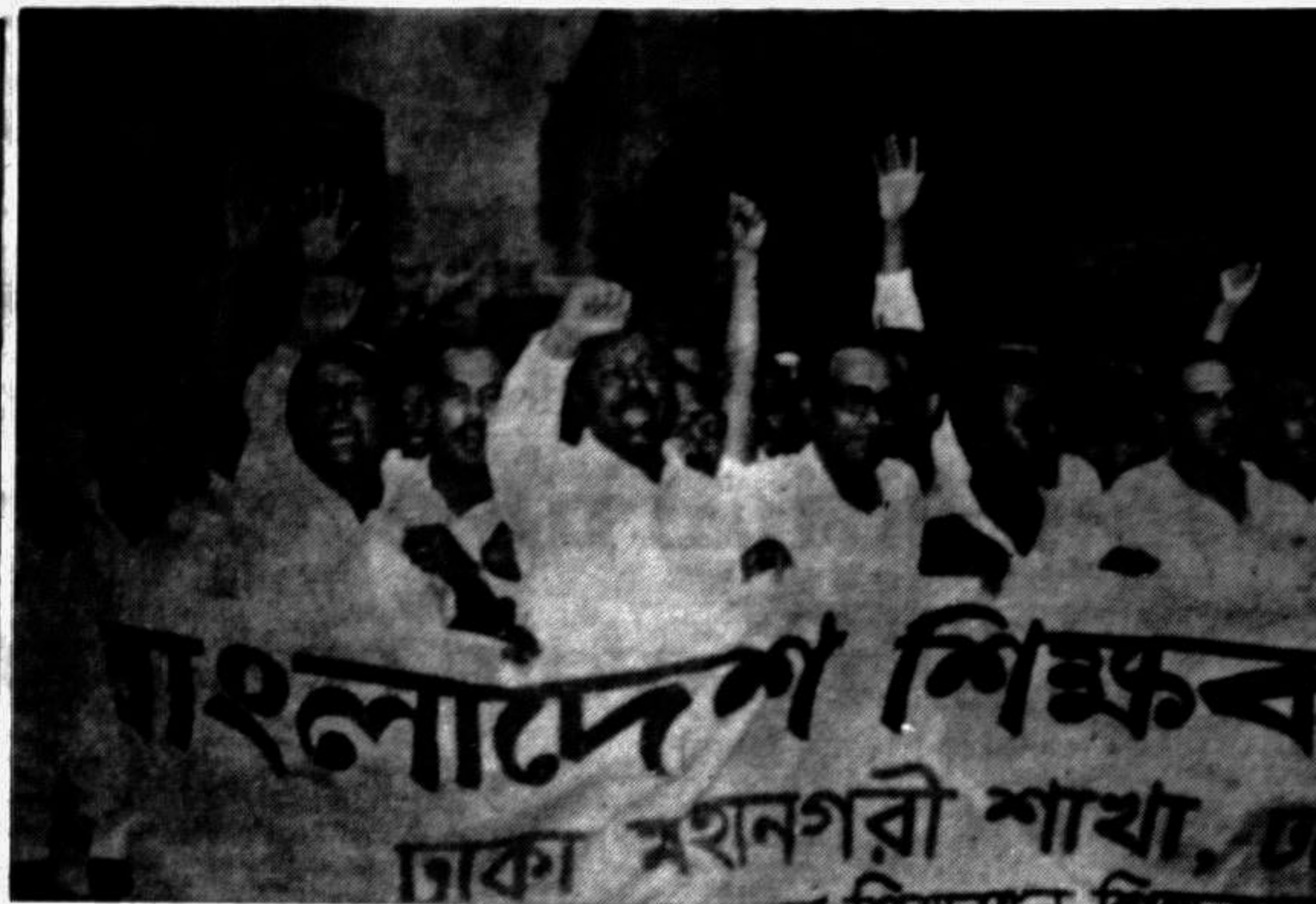
Inaugurated by Moroccan Transport Minister Md Kabbaj, the Congress is being held in Morocco from September 22-28. More than 3000 delegates from 60 countries are participating in this congress. Fifty

ministers led their respective delegations.

Ministers of Bangladesh, France, Italy, FRO, Canada and Mauritania presented their respective country papers, while Prof. Remi Prudhomme of the University of Paris and Prof. Nakamura of the University of Tokyo presented key-note papers in plenary session.

Oli Ahmed dwelt at length on different aspects of the communications and transportation system in Bangladesh and the problems facing in this sector today. He elaborated the ambitious programme undertaken by the Bangladesh government to develop road communication and transportation system.

He said the government of Bangladesh considers that development of road communication had a tremendous im-

'Maintain quality of TV news-casting'

Information Minister Nazmul Huda on Thursday underscored the need for maintaining qualitative standard of news casting in television. He said news casting in television is an important and special type of creative task, reports BSS.

The Information Minister was addressing as the chief guest a certificate giving ceremony of a training course on television news casting organised and conducted by the National Institute of Mass Communication (NIMCO) held in the institute here.

Presided over by Director General of NIMCO Abdullah Al Mamoon, the function was also addressed by Information Secretary Nooruddin Al-Masud Director General of Bangladesh Television Fayzur Razzak, Dr Rafiqul Islam and Mr Abdullah Abu Sayed.

Eleven male and female selected candidates out of 1400 applicants, took part in the three-week long training course and completed the course successfully.

He emphasised the need for exploration and flourishment of talents and genius of the participants in the news presentation in the coming days.

Representatives of the non-tribal from three hill districts at a press conference at the National Press Club on Monday demanded of the government to implement their six-point demands including taking of adequate measures to save them from armed Shantibahini men.

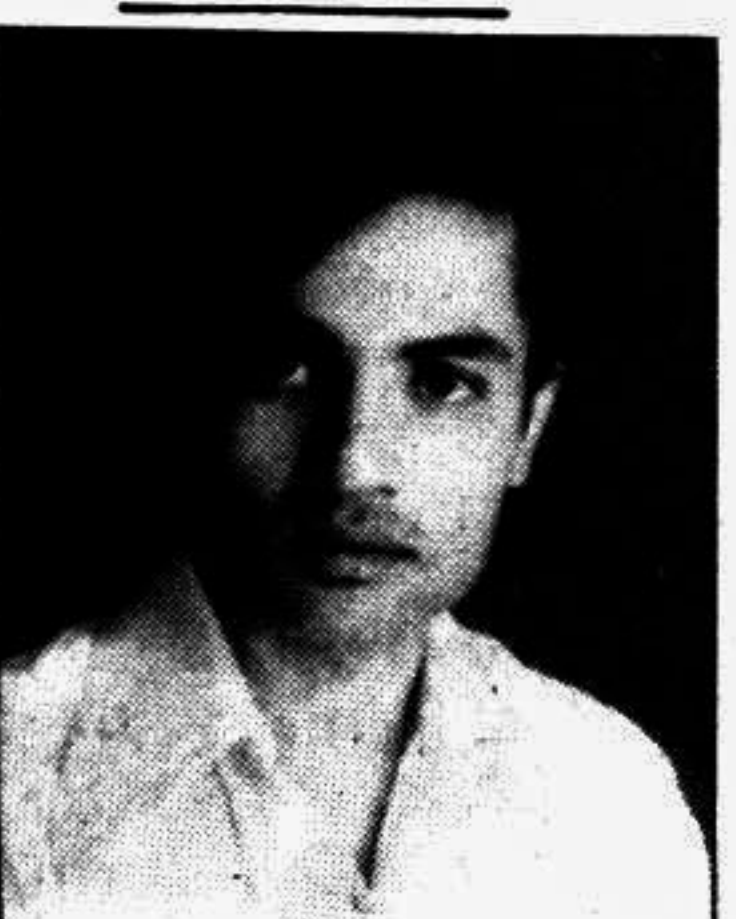
NMA founding anniversary observed
