President should be kept above politics : Suranjit

Gonatanree Party President Suranjit Sengupta has fervently appealed to the Prime Minister to take her bold initiative in choosing the presidential candidate as she did during the passage of the 11th and 12th Constitution Amendment Bills, reports BSS.

In a statement issued in Dhaka Saturday night Sengupta explained the background leading to the nomination of Justice Badrul Haider Chowdhury as their presidential nominee and said that the post of the president, as the only permanent constitutional elective post, should be kept above politics.

Plea to forge consensus on presidential polls

The Co-ordination Council of Bar Associations, Bangladesh, Sunday urged all political parties including the ruling BNP to forge consensus on presidential election, reports UNB.

The call came from an emergency meeting of the executive committee of the co-ordination council held at the office of the Supreme Court Bar Association President. Convenor of the coordination council Shamsul Haq Chowdhury was in the chair.

In a resolution, the meeting resented 'failure' of the government party as well as the opposition to put up a national consensus candidate for the post of President.

Election to the office of President, scheduled for October 13, is a very important step towards transition to constitutional democracy, it noted.

Under the present circum-

stances and at this juncture of the nation, "we believe all political parties, particularly the government party, will perform the responsibility of a patriot by creating consensus in the presidential election."

The meeting was attended, among others, by Barrister Syed Ishtiaq Ahmed, Barrister Amirul Islam, Advocate KM Saifuddin Ahmed, Abdul Basit Majumder, Altaf Hossain, Kabirul Haider and Joydul Abedin.

Diabetic Hospital limping

CHITTAGONG, Sept 29 : The Chittagong Diabetic Hospital established in 1975 and run by Chittagong branch of Diabetic Association of Bangladesh has been limping with time having no building and necessary medical instruments of its own.

General Secretary of Diabetic Association, Chittagong, Jahangir Uddin Chowdhury told BSS today that the hospital had to be shifted three times from one place to another since its inception. The hospital is now housed on the first floor of an abandoned building at Enayet Bazar where acute accommodation problem is faced by the hospital management.

He said that the association has over 10,000 members, of whom 60 to 70 daily come to the hospital for treatment but most of them could not be given proper treatment for

lack of necessary medical instrument and proper pathological tests.

The hospital immediately needs a permanent site and over Taka one crore for purchase of medical instruments for treating the increasing number of diabetic patients coming to the hospital. It now gives free treatment and conducts pathological test free of cost.

The hospital is run entirely on donations by members and philanthropists. It is run on deficit budget every year.

The hospital also urgently needs to establish eye and tooth departments.

Jahangir Uddin said that in spite of repeated approach government response was lacking for development of the diabetic hospital in Chittagong.

He has appealed to the richer section of the people to come to the aid of the hospital.

'Badrul Haider a victim of conspiracy'

A group of 123 advocates of Bangladesh Supreme Court Sunday urged former chief Justice Badrul Haider Chowdhury to refrain from making 'misleading' statements centering the presidential election for the sake of giving an institutional shape to hard earned democracy, reports BSS.

In a joint statement, they said that they had noticed that by accepting the nomination of Awami League for the presidential election, Justice Badrul Haider Chowdhury seemed to be attempting of presenting himself as a consensus candidate. Any attempt at establishing national consensus by excluding other parties, especially the BNP elected to power by massive votes, was misleading and fully impossible, they said.

They further said that though the judicial and legal wisdom of Justice Chowdhury was well known and praiseworthy, he had fallen victim to a 'heinous' conspiracy on a political issue. By becoming a candidate of a particular party without having any prior discussion and obtaining an understanding, Justice Chowdhury had opened the scope for controversy, they observed.

They also described as ridiculous the argument put forward by Justice Badrul

Haider Chowdhury for his candidature that he (Justice Chowdhury) had done so to protest the injustice for not nominating him for the presidency by BNP. Such a decision on the part of Justice Chowdhury was against the spirit of democracy, they added.

The advocates issuing the joint statement include Justice T. H. Khan, Zulmat Ali Khan, Serajul Huq, Abdul Basit Chowdhury, Md. Shahzada, Md Borhanuddin, Md. Anwar Hossain Khan, Md. Hamidur Rahman and Nurul Islam.

Former Minister Ziauddin Ahmed Bablu, a co-accused in the corruption case relating to the purchase of ATP aircraft appeared Saturday morning at the venue of the Special Judge Court, but the proceedings of the court were not held, reports BSS.

The former minister came to the court premises at 9.30 am, at least half an hour before the court starts its session. As a result the reporters missed him and it was inadvertently stated in a BSS story that Ziauddin Ahmed did not turn up.

His lawyer said on arrival at the court venue, the police personnel informed him that the court would not sit and there would be no proceedings. Ziauddin Ahmed later met the jailer of the Dhaka Central Jail who also confirmed him that the proceedings of the court would not be held.

When contacted the jailer told BSS that Ziauddin Ahmed had met him Saturday after he visited the court.
