Mujib's double hattrick in Army's goal glut

Mujib Rahman's brilliant double hattrick helped national champions Bangladesh Army to go on a rampage against a pathetic Bangladesh Police side 10-2 in a completely one-sided mismatch of the Federation Cup football tournament yesterday at Dhaka Stadium.

The second match of the day between Dhaka Division and BJMC needed a tie-breaker to decide the fate of the game with Dhaka Division winning 3-1 to move into the Group D semifinal.

The Dhaka crowd, who saw only eight goals being scored in the first six matches held in the first three days, enjoyed to see yesterday's fanned Armymen run amok blasting ten goals past the helpless Police side to reach the Group D.

The Army booters charmed the crowd with their matchless skill which their rivals Policemen had no arsenal to contain.

They dominated the game in every department and their forwards scored at their own sweet will.

Striker Shafiq opened the flood gate for Army when he nicely nodded teammate Mukhtar's lob from a free kick in the tenth minute of the match.
