

### Power capacity to stand at 43,000 magawatt by 2000

Energy Minister Dr Mosharrar briefed the Chinese Vice Minister about various aspects of the country's power sector and its future expansion programmes, reports UNB.

The country's existing power capacity of 2,300 magawatt will increase to 43,000 magawatt after implementation of various under-construction plants aimed to meet the requirement by 2000 AD, he said. Mosharrar informed the delegation that at present five power plants with a capacity of

830 MW were under the process of construction at different places of the country, which were likely to go into operation by mid-1993.

The two ministers discussed about the progress of the construction work of 210 magawatt thermal power station being constructed at Raizan in Chittagong with Chinese financial and technical assistance. It is due to be completed by 1993.

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia is expected to lay

the foundation stone of the project today.

They also expressed the hope that cooperation between China and Bangladesh would grow further in the years ahead.

The Chinese Vice Minister, who arrived here Friday on a five-day official visit to attend the foundation laying ceremony, expressed his government's willingness to provide necessary assistance to Bangladesh in expanding its power industry.

Chinese Ambassador to Bangladesh Chen Songlu, Energy and Mineral Resources Secretary Azimuddin Ahmed and members of the delegation were present at the meeting.

### 3 DTE officials plan foreign trip on IDA credit

A section of officials in the Directorate of Technical Education (DTE) is trying to obtain a government order just for a foreign trip at the cost of IDA credit.

According to a source in the Directorate of Technical Education three high-ranking officials have already made a Taka 6.60 lakh proposal to the Education Minister to allow them to visit the Geneva-based ILO office for three weeks.

The total cost of the visit will be borne by the ILO and provided by the World Bank as IDA credit.

An agreement was signed between the Bangladesh government and the ILO, Geneva in July 1991 for the procurement of equipment worth Taka three crore through limited international competitive bidding.

The total cost of the equipment is being provided by the World Bank while the ILO is working as a negotiating agency for procuring the equipment to provide man-

### National Immunization Week begins

## Preventive health education in school curricula stressed

The second National Immunization Week (NIW) this year began Saturday to improve public awareness about the country wide Extended Immunization Programme (EPI) and to involve people of all strata to make the programme a success, reports BSS.

Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman inaugurated the week at Osmani Memorial Hall in city on Saturday.

The objective of EPI was to reduce child mortality and morbidity by preventing six diseases — tetanus, measles, whooping cough, diphtheria and tuberculosis through vaccination.

The target of the EPI programme is to eradicate poliomyelitis by the year 2000, neonatal tetanus by 1995 and 90 per cent reduction of incidence measles by 1995. The target of EPI in 1991 is to increase the coverage to 85 per cent from 62 per cent in 1990.

In his inaugural speech M Saifur Rahman emphasised the need for healthy citizens for over all national development.

He said ill health, malnutrition and lack of education were the major causes responsible for our backwardness.
