The Chittagong Port Authority will shortly sign an agreement with the Dutch government providing for 10 million Dutch guilders assistance for the salvage operation, port authority Chairman Akhtar Kamal told The Daily Star Sunday.

According to port survey report, about 20 ships owned by Bangladesh Navy, some foreign companies and the port authority remained sunken which could not be salvaged in the past five months due to lack of finance and expertise.

Meanwhile, the port authority at its board of directors meeting Saturday discussed the overall salvage operation and mobilisation of local fund that would be needed in addi tion to the Dutch assistance.

A Dutch contractor will be engaged in the operation as they are highly expert in this kind of job, the Chairman said. The port would be completely safe for navigation after the operation, Akhtar Kamal said.

The April 29 cyclone left a trail of devastation at Chittagong Port making it totally unsafe for operation. The See Page 12 Col. 6

Massive repair work soon, says Mayor

75 pc city roads damaged

2232 km roads of the capital are either partially or totally damaged - which needs about Taka 100 crore for repair, **Dhaka City Corporation sources**

More than 35 kms of the damaged roads are unusable. No major repair work was done during the past three years which worsened the condition of the city roads.

The Dhaka City Corporation Mayor Mirza Abbas when contacted told The Daily Star Saturday that some initial fund has been allotted for the re-

"We have already begun repair work. We are waiting for a fair weather to start the work in a massive scale". Initially a fund of Taka 30 crores has been sanctioned including Taka 15 erores special allotment by the Prime Minister,

He said that digging of

roads for telephone, WASA, sewerage and gas lines also damage roads. Although the departments concerned take permission from the city corporation for road cutting and pay for their repair, sometimes they remain unrepaired for long time. The corporation is trying to evolve a system of doing the underground and surface worker of such service lines simultaneously through better co-ordination among the departments.

Mirza Abbas said that the anomalies by the autocratic rulers for nine years made the crisis of the city corporation acute. "I visited several damaged roads but bills of their previous repair works remained unpaid," "I am in a fix how can I pay those bills which are not less than some crores of taka," he said.

"I am hopeful that the roads which are in a pitiable conditions will come in a good shape within a couple of months," he said.

Roads in 49 areas in the capital were in very bad condition which included Chankharpul, Bakshibazar, Nilkhet, Jigatala, Tongi Diversion Road, Azimpur, Joykali Mandir, Firebrigade, Agargaon, Samolt, Taltola, Mirpur, Magbazar, Guishan, Airport, Kazi Nazrul Islam Avenue, North South Road, Dholaikhal, Sayedabad and Jattrabari.
