lnaugurating the campaign at a function held at Khamar Bari in Dhaka, Agriculture Minister M Maiid-ul Hug said rat should be identified as the number one national enemy as it was hampering the achievement of self- sufficiency in

According to official statisties rats destroy about 4,50,000 metric tons of rice a year. They also damage about 75,000 metric tons of stored food per annum.

The Minister observed that unlike in other countries mass awareness for killing of rats had not developed in our country. He appealed to all concerned to findout ways to increase this awareness.

He said there should be strong will and aggressive campaign to motivate the people and inspire them for killing rats. He suggested to fix up specific targets for killing rats for village, union, upazila, district and national levels.

The Minister also distributed prizes to the winners of last year's rat control drive. They were farmers, Sheikh M. Alamgir from Bagerhat and M. Abdur Rahim from Muradnagar in Comilla district, and block
