Rat killing campaign begins 4.5 lakh tons rice destroyed a year

A fortnight long 'Aman season rat killing campaign' for 1991 began Tuesday throughout the country, reports BSS.

Inaugurating the campaign at a function held at Khamar Bari in Dhaka, Agriculture Minister M. Majid-ul-Huq said rat should be identified as the number one national enemy as it was hampering the achievement of self-sufficiency in food.

According to official statistics rats destroy about 4,50,000 metric tons of rice a year. They also damage about 75,000 metric tons of stored food per annum.

The Minister observed that unlike in other countries mass awareness for killing of rats had not developed in our country. He appealed to all concerned to findout ways to increase this awareness.

He said there should be strong will and aggressive campaign to motivate the people and inspire them for killing rats. He suggested to fix up specific targets for killing rats for village, union, upazila, district and national levels.

The Minister also distributed prizes to the winners of last year's rat control drive. They were farmers, Sheikh M. Alamgir from Bagerhat and M. Abdur Rahim from Muradnagar in Comilla district, and block who had killed the most rats.

Shahidul Islam said rat killing campaigns were being held for the last eight years in both Aman and Rabi season. He said only 30 per cent of the farmers were aware about the damage caused by rats and the need to kill them.

He said this year a combined efforts by the agricultural research organisations, local government and rural development organisations, Bangladesh Railway, Water Development Board, educational institutions and the NGOs had been taken to make the rat killing fortnight a success.

Activities of the campaign includes, motivation of the people through posters, leaflets, and meetings at village level. Prizes are given to the winners of highest rat killing at different levels to encourage the people.

Buyers of tea inactive, prices fall in auction 1,343 kg saccharin seized

CHITTAGONG, Oct 15: Customs detectives and investigations personnel seized over 1,343 kgs of diamond brand saccharin worth Taka 12,08,648 from a house at the Islam colony at Asadgonj here today, an official source said, reports BSS.

Acting on secret information the customs personnel raided the house and found the saccharin allegedly imported without valid permit.

A departmental case was filed in this connection.

Another report adds: The weekly tea sale held here today was marked by lack of export enquiry as buyers for Iran, Egypt and Poland were absent, market sources said.

Pakistani buyers held much lower limits for a small quantity while internal buyers were also selective. As a result, prices of all categories of teas on offer were at much lower levels. There were considerable withdrawal of different grades of teas.

Bold and Large Broken were neglected and suffered heavy withdrawals. Small Grains Broken met with limited interest and were sold recording a drop of Tk 2.50 to Tk 3 per kg and with fair withdrawals. Poor flaky types were also neglected.

Fannings witnessed only a fair demand and sold at a drop of up to Tk 2.50 per kg over last levels, but here again there were considerable withdrawals.

Of the Orthodox category only a few selected lines were sold at much lower rates.

605 chests of Green Tea on offer met with a good demand for the good liquoring types at generally higher rates while plainer types sold around last levels. Fine Young Hyson sold between Tk 65.00 and Tk 69.80. Young Hyson between Tk 61.50 and Tk 71.10 and Young Hyson (sp) at Tk 64.20 per kg.

3,412 chests of Dust category on offer met with less demand at lower rates with fair withdrawals.

There were 24,695 chests of teas on offer.
