Denmark to give Tk 100 crore

Dhaka-Aricha highway:16 bridges to be rebuilt

Charge d' Affaires of Denmark in Bangladesh K.K. Nielsen called on Communication Minister Oli Ahmed at the Bangladesh Secretariat Wednesday, reports UNB.

They discussed in detail the road and rail communication system in Bangladesh.

The Danish Charge d'Affaires assured to provide all assistance for the reconstruction of Dhaka-Aricha Highway and also of 16 bridges on the road.

He also assured to start expansion work of the two-lane 18 kilometre Dhaka-Nayrhat road into four lanes in the next dry season.

The entire construction work will be completed with Danish grant, according to an official handout.

The Charge d'Affaires also committed to provide Tk 20 crore for the construction of inter-district and regional roads for Borguna and Patuakhali districts. Additional Tk 60 crore will be spent for the construction of roads in greater Barisal district, he added.

Thus a total amount of Tk 100 crore as Danish grant will be spent for road development in the greater Barisal district.

Construction work of roads in Borguna and Patuakhali district will begin in dry season.

Denmark will also provide 21 second class coaches for the Railway (West Zone) by January next under a Danish grant.

Discussion was held for providing more coaches to Bangladesh Railway and the Charge d'Affaires responded positively, the handout said.

Road and Road Transport Division Secretary Nazem Ahmed Chowdhury, Railway Division Secretary Nurul Momen Khan, Chief Engineer of Roads and Highways Department Ataur Rahman, and Counsellor at the Royal Danish Embassy, J.P Pedersen were present.

The meeting was chaired by outgoing President Mrs Sultana Rahman and was attended by 125 delegates from 9 SCI local units.
