



The forum noted that local people's traditional knowledge, wisdom and cultural practices in sustaining and maintaining their natural resources is now emerging at the forefront of challenges to present day development. Together with a wide array of activists and academics there are developing alternatives that form a reassertion of hope to the humanity in the continuous struggle against the present ideology of modernity and progress', the forum ob-
