Rahman Mizan, former minister and son of Sher-e-Bangla, A K Fazlul Huq, Poet Abdul Khaleque, Mr Manindranath Sarkar and Syed Azizul Huq of Sher-e-Bangla Smriti Sangsad. Earlier, in the morning, people from all walks of life visited the mazar, placed wreaths and offered فاتحہ. A milad mahfil and special prayer was offered seeking divine blessings of the almighty for the eternal peace of Sher-e-Bangla.

The participants recalled the pioneering role of the Sher-e-Bangla in awakening the exploited and deprived people of this part of the world. His role in spreading education was also recalled at the meeting.

Rin Salishi Board (Debt Settlement Board) constituted by Sher-e-Bangla in thirties had saved the peasants of the entire Bengal from the exploitation of Mahajans, they said.

Paying tributes to the great leader, the participants said that lessons from the teachings of Sher-e-Bangla could play an important role in consolidating the democracy established in the country.

They demanded the publication of biography, documentation of film on the life and works of Sher-e-Bangla.

In his Presidential speech, Justice Ruhul Islam described Sher-e-Bangla as a great man and said today's politicians were not giving enough attention in grooming the future generation and building the nation as Sher-e-Bangla did.

### Erosion by Bay threatens existence of Sandwip town

CHITTAGONG, Oct 26 : Mustafizur Rahman, MP, today called upon the government to immediately undertake construction of Sandwip town protection embankment, reports BSS.

Addressing a press conference at Press Club here Saturday evening he said that continued erosion by the Bay threatened the existence of Sandwip town.

He said about Taka 400 crore wealth of Sandwip would be devoured by the Bay if embankment was not constructed during the current dry season. Besides, added, over three lakh inhabitants of Sandwip had been passing their days in panic and uncertainty because of continued erosion by the Bay.

Mustafiz also opposed reported shifting of civil and the criminal courts from the old Sandwip town to a new site.

#### Call to boycott terrorists
