The 14th death anniversary of Dr Mohammad Quadrat-e-Khuda, a famous scientist and educationist of the Sub-continent, was observed in Dhaka Sunday in a befitting manner, reports BSS.

In observance of the day the National Museum of Science and Technology and Science Service jointly organised a discussion on 'Chotader Quadrat-e-Khuda' held at the Science Museum Auditorium in the city.

Speakers at the discussion paid rich tributes to Dr Quadrat-e-Khuda and said the best way to pay respect to him was to follow his ideals in building the nation.

Presided over by the Joint Secretary of the Science and Technology Division Khudeza Azam, the discussion was addressed by Prof. Ali Asgar of Engineering University as the main speaker. Director of the Museum Dr Mubarak Ali Akhand, daughter of Dr Quadrat-e-Khuda and a principal scientific officer of BCSIR Hosne

Ara Khan, President of Science Service M Gazdar Rahman and Assistant Curator of the Museum Mustafizur Rahman also participated in the discussion.

Khodeza Azam urged the students to follow the ideals of Dr Quadrat-e-Khuda and utilise their talents through sincerity and devotion for learning and national development.

Recalling the contributions of Dr Quadrat-e-Khuda in education, and industry Dr Ali Asgar said we should discuss the lives of the great men so that the future generation could get direction of their aims and objectives.

He said Dr Quadrat-e-Khuda had a great love for the children and he wrote many scientific articles as well as stories for them. He also edited two popular science magazines for the children titled, 'Bigganer Jotjatra' and 'Purugami Biggan' for a number of years which were published from the BCSIR, he said. Later, he received some articles used by Dr Quadrat-e-

Khuda from Hosne Ara Khan for display at the museum gallery.

BCSIR also organised a discussion on Dr Quadrat-e-Khuda, the founder Director of the laboratory. Presided over by BCSIR Chairman Dr M Waiuzzaman the function was also addressed by BCSIR Dhaka Laboratories Director Dr Safura Nurunnabi, member (Science and Technology) Dr M Yusuf, Dr Saiful Huj, Khandokar M Ismail, Sheikh M Farooq and Mr G K Joarder.
