Accountable govt can check Martial Law

Speaker of the Jatiya Sangsad, Shaikh Razaque Ali, Tuesday said establishment of an effective and accountable government through a sovereign parliament giving institutional shape to democracy can check the martial law, reports BSS.

Speaking as the chief guest at the publication ceremony of a book, "Civil-Military Relations in Bangladesh - A Comparative Study", the Speaker said martial law by no means can be an alternative to democracy.

Held at the auditorium of National Museum, the publication ceremony was attended by Information Minister Nazmul Huda as the special guest.

Presided over by Vice Chancellor of Jahangirnagar University Kazi Saleh Ahmed, the function was addressed by former Information Minister Dr Mizanur Rahman Shelley, Chairman of the Department of Political Science of Dhaka University Prof Imajuddin Ahmed, and the author of the book, Dr Golam Hossain, who is Associate Professor of Government and Politics Department of Dhaka University.

Shaikh Razaque Ali said only an accountable parliamentary democratic system of government could ensure welfare to the people and improve the socio-economic and political conditions in the country.

In this connection, the Speaker pointed out that the present parliament under the leadership of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia had initiated the process of making the government accountable to the parliament through constituting different parliamentary standing committees.

Information Minister Nazmul Huda said the Sipah-i-Janata had untidely stood against all conspiracies against the independence and sovereignty of the country on November 7, 1975.

Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman was the backing of the masses had protected the country through giving proper sense of direction, foiling all conspiracies, Huda said.

He said it was the corrupt politicians who had invited martial law by breaking the unity of the masses. As a result, instead of development, the social and economic fields had been jeopardised in the country.

Appreciating the author for his hard work, the Information Minister hoped that the book would provide a sense of direction to the nation so that martial law under no pretext could take over state power illegally in future.

Dr Mizanur Rahman Shelley said the people of the country first saw martial law in 1958 under Field Marshal Ayub Khan. But the conscious section in the society and the student community waged movement against martial law through the historic education movement in 1962.

Dr Shelley pleaded for well-organised political parties to check martial law in the country.

Prof Imajuddin Ahmed said martial law had come in the country taking advantage of the failures of the political parties.

AL slates voters' enrolment system

Mozaffar Hossain Paltu, President of City Awami League on Tuesday slated the "peculiar and complicated" system of registering names in the Voters List and demanded its immediate cancellation.

In a statement on Tuesday he called for instituting the system of registering voters in a simple manner through the wards or union councils.

He said the system of registering new voters as advertised in the national media by the Election Commission is surprising to the people. The system announced by the Election Commission will never encourage the average voters to include their names in the list. They may even feel discouraged by the complicated procedure, he added.

Call to withdraw new restriction on jatra

Bangladesh Jatra Shilpa Unnayan Parishad has demanded immediate withdrawal of a new government order which prohibits staging of jatra without prior permission from the Home Ministry, reports UNB.

Government recently issued a directive to the district administrations to obtain clearance from the Home Ministry before issuing permission for holding of jatra, circus, fair and exhibitions in their respective jurisdiction.

Protesting the government decision, the Jatra Shilpa Unnayan Parishad Tuesday afternoon organised a rally of owners and artists at Kaptan Bazar in the city.

Presided over by Mohammad Ramzan Mia, owner of Adi Balaka Opera, the rally was addressed, among others, by Parishad General Secretary Milon Kanti Dey, Ganesh Chandra Mondol, Atoar Rahman, Nilufar Yasmin, Sukumar Karmakar, Sultan Selim and Narayan Mondol.

Speakers at the rally said the new restriction would hinder the normal growth of "jatra," a major source of entertainment for the rural people.

It would also make uncertain the fate of a large number of professional jatra artists and their families, they said adding that jatra is the only means of their livelihood.

Organisers of the rally said at present there are 210 licensed opera groups in the country who employ more than 17,000 professional jatra artists.

They said the government had set up a five-member committee in 1988 to formulate a jatra policy but the committee was yet to submit its report.

Khandker Rafiqul Haq's death condoled

National Federation of VOA Fan Clubs and Bangladesh News Readers Association Tuesday held a meeting condoled the death of VOA Bengali Service news reader Khandker Rafiqul Haq, reports UNB.

Presided over by the News Readers Association President Aminul Haq, the meeting was addressed by VOA Correspondent and Convener of Federation of VOA Fan Clubs, Bangladesh, Gias Kamal Chowdhury and Joint Convener A E Talukder Pavel.

BADC tube-wells to be sold to farmers

The government has decided to sell all new deep tube-wells, old deep tube-wells, shallow tube-wells and power pumps of Bangladesh Agriculture Development Corporation (BADC) to the farmers at a cheaper rate by the end of March next year, reports BSS.

A meeting was held Tuesday in the Secretariat with Additional Agriculture Secretary Ershadul Haque in the chair to review the progress of sale of agriculture equipment. Senior officials of the Ministry of Agriculture, BADC, BRDB and mass media organisations were present in the meeting, an official source said.

The meeting was informed that during the period from July 1 to October 28 in the current year, 101 new deep tube-wells, 380 old deep tube-wells, 382 shallow tube-wells and 1056 power pumps of BADC had been sold to the farmers.

The speakers stressed the need for wider publicity of sale of unsold agriculture equipment on radio, television, newspaper and other mass-media to attract the attention of the farmers.

Moiddha Badda connecting road committee

The residents of the Moiddha Badda in a meeting recently formed a 31-member committee called "connecting road implementation committee" to persuade authorities to construct long-planned road connecting Moiddha Badda with Progoti Sarani in Gulshan to ease the communication, reports BSS.

M Ziauddin Ahmed and M A Hashem will head the committee as President and General Secretary respectively, a press release said on Tuesday. The residents also formed a seven-member Advisory Committee to help the implementation committee.

Shantibahini activist arrested

CHITTAGONG, Nov 12 : Security forces arrested one alleged outlawed Shantibahini activist and recovered one country made gun and four rounds of bullet from his possession Monday, reports UNB.

Acting on a secret information, security forces arrested Rangu Chan Chakma (30) while collecting tolls from the people at Suknachari area of Laxmichari upazila.

They also recovered the tolls collected from the people including some related documents.

One stabbed to death

Our Correspondent adds : One person was stabbed to death and another sustained serious injuries by an irritated employee at the Padma Oil Company office at Patenga on Tuesday.

Munir Ahmed, a security guard of the Padma Oil Company terminal who was earlier suspended for negligence of duties entered the office of the Security Officer, Kaiser Ahmed Choudhury, and stabbed him repeatedly. The Operation Controller Fazole Ahmed, who tried to resist the attacker, was also stabbed. Later other employees came and managed to capture and disarm the attacker.

Kaiser Ahmed Choudhury (40) succumbed to his injuries after being admitted to the Chittagong Medical College Hospital. Fazole Ahmed (35) was admitted to a private clinic where his condition is stated to be critical.

The assailant was handed over to the Port Authority police.

A case has been filed.

Tea market

Buyers for Iran and Pakistan were quite active while Poland lent support for some selective items at the weekly tea sale held in Chittagong on Tuesday.

Prices of brokens continued to be depressing and were much lower than their corresponding fannings where there was a good competition from Pakistan and Iranian buyers as well as internal market. Internal buyers lent some support for a few select lines of well made brokens.
