France to build 50 cyclone shelters in coastal areas

CHITTAGONG, Nov 19: French Ambassador in Bangladesh Serge Degal said here Monday that the literary and cultural exchange between Bangladesh and France would be strengthened in future, reports BSS.

He was speaking at the publication ceremony of the Bengali translation of French writer Charles Perrault's tales by Gurupada Chakraborty at Alliance Francaise here.

Director of the Alliance Francaise Gerard Oppé and translator Gurupada Chakraborty also spoke.

Barisal Development Council
