**Concern over decision to scrap UZ parishads**

The meeting, presided over by Convener of the Association Ferroz Kabir, observed that the country's people will never let such decision to go unchallenged.

The meeting said the decision to dissolve the Parishads came when the nation expecting to step up development-oriented programmes under the leadership of democratically elected public representatives.

The meeting also urged the patriotic forces to resist such undemocratic step.

**Tk 242 cr to be spent on Ctg city development projects**

CHITTAGONG, Nov 20 : Chittagong City Corporation (CCC) will spend Taka 242 crore on various development projects including reexcavation of Chaktal Canal at a cost of Taka 3.75 crore during the next five years, report BSS.

Of the total amount, Taka 150 crore will be spent for execution of 723 projects which included reconstruction of roads, culverts, bridges, while Taka 92 crore will be spent for environmental development projects of the City Corporation.

In an exclusive interview with BSS, the Mayor of CCC Mir Mohammad Nasir Uddin said that construction and repairing works of roads, bridges and culverts would be undertaken in 41 wards of the Corporation. Priority would be given to under develop wards of the Corporation while executing the development projects, he said.

The Mayor said, works on 80 projects have already started involving an expenditure of Taka 11 crore. Bakhalia, Chandgaon, Sholshahar, Paharali, Halishahar,

Babzed Bostami and Madarbari arc among the underdeveloped wards on the City Corporation where development projects would be implemented on priority basis, he further said.

The Mayor said that the re-excitation works of 9,435 metre Chaktal Canal will start in January next at a cost of Taka 3.75 crore. He said, taka 5.44 crore has already been paid for acquisition of land in this connection, the Chaktal reexcavation project is a part of Taka 92 crore World Bank finance environment development programme of the city.

Under this programme a total of 10 Community latrines and four bridges will be constructed at a cost of Taka 66 lakh and 27 lakh respectively. Among the four bridges one is a traffic while other three are foot bridges.

In Bakalia area, K B Aman Ali Road will be reconstructed at a cost of Taka 16.50 lakh. The construction of six community latrines, out of ten, had already been started.

The Mayor said that a mini park would be developed around local circuit house in-

volving an expenditure of Taka 15 lakh. Preliminary works have already been completed in this connection.

Mir Nasruddin said the corporation incorporating local people with the CCC development activities in this connection. He said that an advisory committee had already been constituted for implementation of the Chaktal Canal reexcavation project.

In reply to a question he said about 663 irregular appointments in CCC by the past regime are being regularised through proper rules and regulations of the Corporation.

The Mayor said the Corporation is to pay an additional amount of Taka five crore as salary of those irregular appointments.

Regarding development of Patenga Sea Beach the Mayor said that some projects would be taken up after completion of the construction of Patenga protection embankment.

In reply to another question, the Mayor said with a smile, "I am facing no problems in discharging my responsibility as Mayor of the City Corporation."

They also submitted a memorandum to the president demanding withdrawal of upazila courts and separation of judiciary from the administration.

While exchanging views with the members of the delegation, the President said the lawyers had played an important role in introducing democracy in the country.

He also hoped that the lawyers would extend their all out cooperation in ensuring rule of law and consolidating the parliamentary system in the country.

The President also gave a patient hearing to problems of the lawyers and assured to look into them.
