Amongst these forests, Sundarban occupies a very special place. Its physical features, river network, innumerable variety of trees, huge reservoir of fish, and above all the spotted Chitral Deer and the world famous Royal Bengal Tiger have endowed the forest with vast riches. No other forest has so much forest related resources as Sundarban. The Honey and Wax of Sundarban is

famed throughout the country. Sundarban is a mangrove

forest. Compared to other forests it is much more productive. A lot of people (Mowals) are engaged in extracting Honey and Wax. The job is a seasonal one; Work starts from 1st April and lasts up to 30th June. Although dozens of people die because of tiger bites each year, as Honey-collection is a very profitable vocation lots of 'Mowals' continue to live on it.

The people who collect 'Jhinuk', are known as 'Jongra Khuta.' Jhinuk is found both within the forest and also by the seaside. After collection these are sold at Hats and Bazars. By burning 'Jhinuk', lime can be produced.



also used as pillars, in betel leaf cultivation, and in fences. In addition, its balm is used for colouring nets.

The use of 'Amur' wood is widespread in handicrafts. 'Singra', 'Jhana', Kirpa, etc trees are used as fuel wood and as pillars. Extraction of 'Nal', 'Hogla', 'Patipata', 'Chhan', 'Heli' grass and 'Ulu' grass etc. provides profitable employ-

Almost 73% of wood production of Sundarban consists of 'Sundari' wood. It is used in house-building, pools, culverts, boats, launch, bus, truck, electrical poles and in various mills and factories. A large percentage of demand for fuelwood in the country is met from this wood. It is also used as raw material for Khulna Hardboard

Around 16% of the wood produced in Sundarban comprises of 'Geoa'. It is used as raw materials at Khulna Newsprint Mills. Besides, the largest match factories of the country use it as raw material.

Kakra, Keora, Bain, Dhundal, etc account for around 11% of wood produced in Sundarban. They are used in construction work, furnitures,

agri-equipment, toys etc. They are also widely used as fuelwood.

Sundarban is located by the side of the sea and during day time it is inundated by tidal waters. The water is naturally salty. According to differences in salt composition, the forest is divided into three regions.

The most lively and fast growing trees grow in the region. with least saltiness. As the proportion of salt increases; the shrubs are found in larger quantities.

Amongst the fauna that are seen in Sundarban the outstanding ones are Royal Bengal Tiger, 'Chitra Deer,' Monkey, Jackal, Pigs, Shajaru, 'Udbiral', Kathbiral, Crocodile, Dolphin, Shark and various types of snakes.

The birds include native birds such as Kingstork, Snipe, Hawk, Baj, Machhranga, Madantak, Gangcheel, Gangkabutar, Parrots, Owl, Harial, Ghooghu, Doyel, Shalik etc. During winter a massive flock of foreign birds come to this forest. These include Swan, Grey Swan, Jhati Hansh, Kal Hansh, Ranga Hansh,

various rivers and canals (by means of boats, nets and barshi). In winter, a large number of fishermen come from different areas of the country to catch fish from the char areas which surface in the sea coast. These fishes are dried in the chars and then supplied to far-flung areas of the country. Fresh fish is marketed locally and frozen fish. which include shrimps, are
