A total of 6,365 students appeared in the examinations of whom 4,688 came out successful. The percentage of pass is 73.65.

**Illiteracy to be eradicated within 10 years: Sircar**

Works Minister Rafiqul Islam Mia Thursday said BNP government was determined to establish a society free from violence and corruption, reports BSS.
