Zahiruddin admits fragility of planning mechanism

Planning Minister M Zahiruddin Khan Saturday called for mobilising public opinion against the mismanagement in the public sector enterprises and its subsequent impact on the national exchequer, reports BSS.

While inaugurating a seminar on "unemployment and industrialisation" the minister referred to the recent blockade protesting the denationalisation of mismanaged public enterprises and said "we could no longer afford to be dictated by a handful of indisciplined workers regarding our economic policies."

Zahiruddin said, the pursuing of patriotic economic policies was the main factor behind the success of the industrially developed nations and added "unless we manage our economic well we would become poorer and poorer."

He regretted that the major draw back in the country's planning was the absence of a goal, well defined strategies and the mechanism of implementing the plan. If, the minister said, things were not set to right the nation might head for disastrous socio-economic situation.

Zahiruddin said the prime goal of the nation's development effort should be to accelerate and sustain productive employment.

The level of economic development of a nation is directly linked with creation of productive employment opportunities, he said.

The Planning Minister said, in the present day world the level of patriotism of a nation could only be judged from the economic policies it pursued. Steps for creation of more employment opportunities and restricted import bill were the manifestation of a patriotic economic policy, he added.

Dr Iqbal Mahmud, a Professor of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology and a former State Minister presented the keynote paper at the seminar organised by "Forum for Engineers and Architects." Forum President Abul Hasan presided.

Cancellation of plan on import of salt demanded

Jamaat-e-Islami Bangladesh leader Enamul Haq MP Saturday demanded the cancellation of the decision on the import of salt, reports BSS.

In a statement, Haq said that hundreds of salt producers of Cox's Bazar and others connected with salt, would be faced with an uncertain future following the government decision to allow liberal import of salt. This decision has frustrated the salt growers and others connected with it, he pointed out.

He said during a discussion with the Commerce Minister after the April 29 cyclone, they had advised him to allow the import of a limited quantity of salt so that no scarcity was created in the market before the salt producing season of January-February, 1992.

Mostafiz leaves for Dakar OIC to talk ME, Afghan issues

Foreign Minister A S M Mostafizur Rahman left Dhaka Saturday to attend the meeting preparatory to the next summit of the Organisation of Islamic Conference (OIC).

Thrust of the summit this time will be greater interaction among the Muslim nations, he told BSS at the airport prior to departure.

The Foreign Minister said the sixth summit of the OIC would discuss a number of burning issues facing the Islamic world like the Middle East crisis and Afghan tangle.

However, Rahman said, economic cooperation among the Muslim states was assuming a greater importance these days and expressed the hope that the conference would devote much of its deliberations to this aspect.

The Foreign Minister said it would be the first attendance by Prime Minister Khalesa Zia in a gathering of Islamic leaders and added that her talks with the leaders of different members of the OIC would be useful for the nation.

Bangladesh has now greater respectability in the Islamic arena as well as international world after a democratic government has taken over in the country, he said.

The summit will begin at the Senegalese capital of Dakar from December 9.

Senior officials and the Foreign Minister will lay a ground for their leaders to the four-day summit.

EDM's mother uplift plan replicated in 5,120 villages

The Bangladesh Government has replicated Enfants du Monde model of mothers' welfare programme in 5,120 villages. This was disclosed by the Secretary of the Ministry of Social Welfare M Faizullah at a meeting with Mrs Elisabeth Haemmig, Director, Programmes, EDM Geneva in Dhaka recently.

M Faizullah told Mrs Haemmig that the mothers' project was approved by the Executive Committee of the National Economic Council. In yet another meeting between the Director-General of the Department of Social Services Abdul Bari and Mrs Haemmig, the contribution of the Geneva-based EDM to different social welfare projects throughout Bangladesh was recalled. The Director-General deeply appreciated the existing model of the EDM and its implementation procedure evolved out of the EDM assistance.

Meanwhile, the Director, Programmes of EDM-Geneva visited various projects of the leading the non-government organisation in Bangladesh and expressed satisfaction over the progress in this regard.

Among the projects visited by her during her stay are rural family and child welfare project, EDM handicraft, EDM-Saturia, EDM-boys homes, under privileged children's education programmes and centre for training and rehabilitation of destitute women project.

Enfants Du Monde is a Swiss non-governmental organization with headquarters in Grand Saconnex/ Geneva, founded in 1968, with a long history in development assistance to Bangladesh.

The "Rural Family and Child Welfare Project," is not only the oldest, but also the largest of all projects. It started in 1974 as an experimental project in 5 villages, as a result of which it has been replicated in more than 1000 villages during the past, in 4 major phases throughout the country.

The "EDM Handicraft" project is a self-sustaining export oriented handicraft programme, generating a source of income for more than 1300 traditional artisan families with an export volume worth Tk 10 million a year.

The "EDM-Saturia" rural development project is evolved out of a disaster rehabilitation project for 1700 families, with the same main aims and objectives as those of the Rural Family and Child Welfare Project.

The "EDM-Boys Homes," provides shelter, education and vocational training to 200 boys from destitute families.

The "Underprivileged Children's Education Programme" is an educational programme for 5,800 working street children in Khulna and Chittagong cities alone.

The "Centre for Training and Rehabilitation of Destitute Women" project, is designed to rehabilitate abandoned pregnant women and abandoned children, through vocational training for mothers and foster homes for children.

The EDM makes relief and rehabilitation efforts in times of natural calamities. The EDM flood shelters at village level, was erected in joint collaboration with the Swiss Government.

The EDM housing programme is a contribution towards an improved family accommodation on low cost basis in rural Bangladesh.
