PDB to be sued if it buys poles from India

Local manufacturers Sunday threatened they would sue power Development Board if it buys electric poles and accessories from India for a World Bank-financed project, reports UNB.

In a letter to the PDB chairman, they local suppliers again said the Indian bidder was "totally non-responsive" and "bluffed" many ways the PDB and the World Bank itself to get the supply order for the 16-town power project.

They alleged the Indian company, Jindal, strongly recommended by the World Bank for the contract, didn't even update in time the bid bond and bid validity, breaching all norms of tender.

By not extending the bid bond and bid validity, the foreign company has also deprived the Janata Bank of its due commission.

The protesters also demanded of PDB to blacklist the Indian firm for its contrivances that also "strained

relations between World Bank and PDB".

The local manufacturers pointed out they were forced to stop production in their factories because of huge stockpile of products.

Controversy over the electric pole purchase contract has been on for the last several months as the Bank is preferring the Indian company while the executing agency, PDB, disliking the foreign company, saying it's "non-responsive".

PDB sources said they would have to spend an additional 3.5 million dollar for

CDST in case of purchase abroad.

In its latest letter to the PDB, the World Bank vented its wrath over delay in awarding the supply order to the Indian company and asked the power board to give the contract to Jindal by December 31.

Local manufacturers have also written to the World Bank President in Washington to review its position over the purchase contract. The World Bank chief's response is awaited.
