The Doctors Association of Bangladesh (DAB) Monday prayed for the peace of the departed soul of shaheed Dr Milan at a milad mahfil, held at his office at Green Road, Dhaka, reports BSS.

Prior to the milad, a short discussion was held on the life and activities of Dr Milan.

Deputy Leader of the Jatiyatabadi Sangsad Prof. A Q M Badruddoza

Chowdhury, adviser of DAB Prof M A Halim, DAB President Dr A K M Qamaruzzaman MP and Secretary General Dr M Atiqur Rahman participated in the discussion.

Speaking on the occasion, Prof. Chowdhury said the contributions of all those including Dr Milan and Noor Hossain, who had sacrificed their lives during the movement for democracy, would be evaluated. He demanded speedy trial of the killers of Dr Milan. The physicians must think

about the people and the country, he said adding, being imbued with this spirit Dr Milan participated in the mass movement of 1990 and sacrificed his life.

Recalling the sacrifices of the physicians during the language movement in 1952 and the war of liberation in 1971 Prof Chowdhury said the doctors' community had sacrificed themselves again and again at the need of the hour.

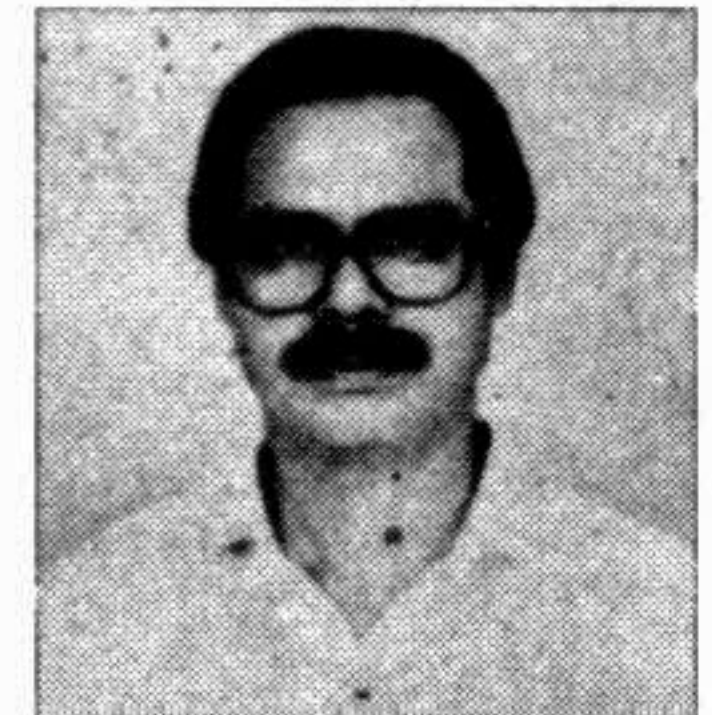

He said that DAB would set up a centre of shaheed Ziaur Rahman free Friday clinic at Salmullah Orphanage soon and it would be dedicated in memory of Dr Milan. Organised by DAB the clinic now is in operation at Nawab Yusuf Market in the old city area.

Dateline Chittagong Call to create awareness to fight against AIDS

CHITTAGONG, Dec 2 : A day-long seminar on World AIDS Day was observed in Dhaka Sunday with a call to create mass awareness through spread of education to fight against the killer disease AIDS, reports BSS.

The seminar was held at the lecture room of Chittagong Medical College with Principal of the College Prof Noor-un-Nabi in the chair.

Prof M Salehuddin, Prof A Mannan Sikder, Prof S Hossain, Prof Mohammad Rezaul Karim, Dr Pravat Chandra Barua and WIO Consultants Dr MN El Naggar and Prof Mythen were, among others, who presented papers on different aspects on AIDS.

Principal Noor-un-Nabi, in his presidential speech, underlined the importance of non-governmental initiatives along with government in creating mass consciousness about the origin and prevention of the deadly disease.

Shibir withdraws strike

UNB adds : Second year semester final examination of the Polytechnic Institute here was held peacefully yesterday following permission by the authorities to allow five Islamic Chhatra Shibir activists to appear.

Meanwhile, Shibir in a statement condemned the firing incident in the campus allegedly by the Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal activists in the morning.

Chhatra Shibir staged demonstration, observed strike in educational institutions and called a full day hartal which was observed Saturday in the city as

Polytechnic Institute authorities barred those Shibir activists from taking the examination due to lack of required percentage.

Shibir withdrew their strike and Sunday's gherao programme following assurances from the Dhaka Technical Education Board.

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal criticised the "irrational" decision to permission to Shibir activists to appear in the examination under pressure.

Meanwhile, Shibir blamed JCD for resorting to violence in the institute in the morning. Shibir held a meeting at gate number 2 of Sholohar, near the institute and later brought out a procession.

Workshop on jute, ecology Dec 10

A day-long workshop on "Jute and Bangladesh Ecology" will be held on December 10 at the Bangladesh Agricultural Research Council (BARC) auditorium in Dhaka, reports BSS.

Jointly organised by Commonwealth Human Ecology Council-Bangladesh (CHEC-Bangladesh) and BARC the workshop will discuss different problems and prospects of the jute growers, and the jute industries and the related environmental issues.

Jute Minister Hannan Shah and Planning Minister Zahiruddin Khan are expected to participate in the inaugural session of the workshop.

During the workshop an exhibition of the jute products jointly organised by the Bangladesh Jute Research Institute (BJRI) and the Bangladesh Jute Mills Corporation (BJMC) will also be held at BARC premises, the sponsors said.
