SAARC chamber in Pakistan

CHITTAGONG, Dec 4: Chittagong Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCCI) will soon begin to work with Lahore Chamber of Pakistan as 'sister chamber' in a bid to boost trade between Bangladesh and Pakistan, the President of Chittagong Chamber Engineer Ali Ahmed disclosed.

Addressing a press conference at Chittagong Chamber office today Ahmed, recently toured two SAARC countries — India and Pakistan as head of 12-member delegation, said a memorandum of understanding to this effect was signed between both the chambers with the spirit of SAARC.

The delegation mainly visited those two countries in order to develop economic union aimed at creating a trade bloc among the SAARC countries like that of EEC, said the president of the chamber flanked by two of his vice presidents Abul Kalam and Jafrul Islam Chowdhury.

The other objectives of the visit were to find ways and means to narrow down the trade imbalance between Bangladesh and other neighbouring SAARC countries.

He informed the first executive committee meeting of the SAARC chamber will be held in Bangladesh while the first president will be selected from Pakistan.

The headquarters of the chamber will be set up in Pakistan, he also informed.

Ahmed said, during his visit he observed the export prospect of Bangladeshi betel leaf and tea in Pakistan is bright.

He also suggested tariff preferences from Bangladesh side to help narrow down the imbalance.

He said Indian entrepreneurs were keen to set up joint venture.

Replying to a question raised by this correspondent about the illegal border trades the chamber president said, tariff preferences could help to formalise this practice.

Giving a picture of trade imbalance, the chamber president said, India's export to Bangladesh in the fiscal year 1990-91 had recorded to rupees 547.38 crore as against 31.43 crore rupees of export from Bangladesh to India.

All the previous fiscal year record also showed the same sort of trade gap, he said.

GOVERNMENT

Thailand is governed by a constitutional monarchy with a parliamentary form of government. The Bangkok Metropolitan Administration is administered by an elected governor and is divided into 24 districts. The country is divided into 72 provinces, each administered by an appointed governor, which are sub-divided into districts, sub-district, groups of villages and villages.

FLAG

Thailand's national flag, ceremoniously raised each morning in every town and village, is composed of five horizontal bands of red, white, and blue. Outer bands of red representing the nation enclose equal inner bands of white evoking religion. The blue band, occupying the central one-third of the total area, symbolizes the monarchy. The harmony of design expresses the complimentary nature of these three pillars of the Thai nation.

This tri-coloured flag, first introduced by King Vajiravudh (Rama VI) in 1917, succeeded an earlier design which placed a white elephant (emblem of the absolute monarch) on a red background.

NATIONAL SYMBOLS

The Thai national and royal symbol is the Garuda, a mythical half-bird half-human figure (steed of the Hindu god Vishnu) that adorns King Bhumibol Adulyadej's scepter and royal standard, many ministries and department have incorporated the Garuda into their insignias. Moreover the Garuda is significant of "By Royal Appointment" and is awarded, at the personal discretion of His Majesty the King, as a sign of royal approval to companies that have rendered outstanding economic and charitable services to Thailand. Such an award is rarely bestowed and is considered a great honour.

NATIONAL COLOURS

Thailand has no official national colours, although the use of red, white, and blue, inspired by the colours of the Thai flags are used by Thai international sporting teams, as well as on other appropriate occasions.

NATIONAL DRESS

Although there is no official national dress, the traditional dress has been adopted as the unofficial national costume and can be seen on both formal and informal occasions. For women, it is a full length pashin — a rectangular piece of cloth worn like a skirt or sarong — generally made of Thai silk. The pashin can be of any colour and generally has contrasting bands around the hem. It is worn with a long-sleeved silk blouse. On formal occasions a sash may be worn across the breast from the left shoulder to the right part of the waist. For men, the traditional dress is trousers with a "seua phra ratchathan," as short-sleeved shirt (long-sleeved for formal occasions) with a high collarless neck. On formal occasions, a cummerbund is tied around the waist.

'Teachers' role important to remove illiteracy'

RAJSHAH, Dec 4: State Minister for Land Kabir Hossain today called upon the teachers to work with sincerity and dedication imbued with the spirit of patriotism to make the mass education programme a success, reports BSS.
