Coming JS session to review newsmen's issues: Speaker

The Speaker of the Jatiya Sangsad, Sheikh Razaque Ali, Monday said the issues relating to the implementation of the journalists' wage board award, their service condition and other aspects would be sent to the parliamentary standing committee on information ministry for an elaborate review during the coming session of the parliament, reports BSS.

He said the government was well aware of the present condition of the journalists, litterateurs and poets and hoped that it would take well-thought-out measures for resolving their problems.

The Speaker was addressing the cheque-awarding ceremony organised for distressed journalists at the National Press Club in Dhaka Monday. Karnafully Insurance Company, which has formed the "Karnafully Insurance Company Journalists Welfare Fund, organised the function to hand over cheques to 16 journalists.

Commerce Minister M K Anwar, President of Dhaka Union of Journalists Zahirul Haq and Chairman of Insurance Association Maidul Islam also spoke.

Nizamuddin Ahmad, Editor of the Weekly Muktibani and Chairman of Karnafully Insurance Company, presided

over the function. Describing the journalists as "conscience of the nation," the Speaker wondered why they would be identified as distressed. He said this community was engaged in rendering relentless service to the country but it was yet to get due honour or be properly rehabilitated in society.

Speaking about the present parliament and its activities, Sheikh Razaque Ali said both the government and the opposition were jointly taking decisions through discussing various issues in the respective parliamentary committees.

The Speaker called upon the journalists to focus the activities of the parliamentary committees on the newspaper pages so that the people could know how the government was being made accountable to the nation.

The Commerce Minister said the government had already taken various measures and would take further steps for resolving the problems of the journalist community. The government was trying to solve the problems of the journalists in phases, he said.

Anwar called upon the well-to-do section of the society to come forward in aid of the distressed humanity. He thanked the authority of Karnafully Insurance Company for their

noble gesture in helping the distressed journalists.

The DUJ President congratulated the authority of Karnafully Insurance Company for its initiative but regretted that "conscience of the nation" was being identified as distressed.

He said the journalists wage board award was being implemented in all the newspapers in Bangladesh. He called upon the government to look into the issues alongwith other related aspects of the journalist community through the parliamentary committee on information ministry.

Education key to all development: Tariq

Briefly speaking on the occasion, Mrs Sanni thanked the organisers for honouring her with the title. She also spoke highly about the people of Bangladesh, especially those who are involved in literary and cultural fields.

STD clinics at dist level suggested

On the second day of the national workshop on Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STD) now being held in Dhaka the participants suggested extension of the skin and STD clinics at district level with all necessary logistic support, reports BSS.

At present the facilities for diagnosis and treatment of STD are available only at the medical college hospitals and the IPGMR, the workshop was told.

The participants suggested undertaking separate programmes for the different risk groups and sensational sites like the sea ports and the entry points for prevention and control of STD.

Giving emphasis on creating public awareness of different aspects of prevention and

control of STD including AIDS, the workshop said mass media should be utilised for this purpose.

The workshop found the present disease reporting profile as "unworkable" and suggested to update the system and include STD in it.

Presenting a paper at the workshop on strategy of STD programme in Bangladesh Prof A Z M Maidul Islam of IPGMR suggested refresher courses on STD for both the medical and paramedical personnel to update their knowledge in this field.

The workshop also discussed integration of AIDS programme with prevention and control of STD programmes.
