Two thousand people including 200 tribal women and children were killed in the terrorist activities in the trouble-torn Chittagong Hill Tracts since 1980, a seminar paper on human rights said Tuesday.

The paper on "Human Rights and the Chittagong Hill Tracts" also revealed that nearly 4000 people received bullet wounds, fire burn or in-

dwellers of the hilly regions were abducted during that period, the paper said.

The seminar, jointly organised by the Bangladesh Human Rights Commission and the Institute of Rural Journalists. was addressed, among others, by the Convenor of the Coordination Council of the Bar
