Move to restore autocracy won't succeed : Biswas

President Abdur Rahman Biswas said here on Sunday that the nation wanted both the government and the opposition to work together for the preservation of hard earned democracy in the country, reports BSS.

There is no alternative to democracy and the success in the long struggle against autocracy has proved that the present generation was in favour of democracy and therefore, any attempt to restore autocracy was nothing but a day-dreaming," he added.

The President was speaking at a function organised by the metropolitan unit of Zia Shishu Kishore Sangathan in celebration of the Victory Day.

Held at the National Museum Auditorium the function was presided over by Mr Mosharraf Hossain Buyian, Convener of the city unit of the organisation. It was addressed, among others, by Dr SM Lutfur Rahman, Dr Shahida Rafiq, Mr Serajul Islam Selim and Mrs Zakia Sultana.

President Biswas said terrorism posed a serious problem at the moment and added, a nation could not march forward if this terrorism was not curbed.

He urged all including conscious citizens, educated people, intellectuals, journalists, teachers and youths to contribute their mite in eliminating terrorism from the society.

He said the nation was now striving hard to establish a democratic social system. With this end in view, he added, a bright future for the posterity had to be ensured following the ideals of President Ziaur Rahman.

He said the present government was keen to build the children as worthy citizens so that they could lead the nation in future. In this context, he added, the government had undertaken plans to set up Shishu Academy in 22 more districts.

The President said the government has already taken steps to preserve the memories of those juveniles who had been killed during the Liberation War.

President Biswas said despite Bangladesh being a geographically small county it had a glorious tradition as a nation.

The President paid homage to the martyrs of the Liberation War and reminded the nation to maintain its commitment to make independence meaningful.
