Campus terrorism still continues

The second annual meeting of International Relations Alumni Association of Dhaka University has expressed concern over continuance of closing down of a large number of educational institutions and deteriorating law and order situation, reports BSS.

The violence and terrorism that started with the past autocratic regime, still continues, a resolution of the meeting said on Friday.

The association urged Prime Minister Begum Khaleida Zia and her government to take punitive actions against those responsible for such violence, particularly in the educational institutions.

Workers urged to refrain from destructive politics

Law and Justice Minister Mirza Golam Hafez on Saturday called upon the employees of mills and factories at Savar to put in their best efforts to boost production through maintaining congenial atmosphere, reports BSS.

Addressing a gathering of Sramik-Karmachari of Kohinoor Spinning Mills at Nayerhat, the Law Minister said that present democratic Government was very much sympathetic to the legitimate demands of workers and as such their majority problems had already been solved.

He urged them to refrain from destructive and negative politics for pressing home their demands. He suggested them to come up with reasonable proposal so that the Government could fulfil their demands within available resources.

Chief Whip Khandakar Delwar Hossain also addressed the gathering. Among others, labour leaders Razaul Karim, Minhajuddin, Moazzem, Ali Ahmed and Md. Nabi Hossain spoke on the occasion.

An earlier report from Gopalganj adds: Mirza Golam Hafez has said the BNP government will establish the political, economic and social rights of the scheduled caste community through fulfilment of its election commitment.

It was addressing as the chief guest a largely attended public meeting organised by 'Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Talsil Cell in Gopalganj' on Friday.

Agriculture and Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control Minister M. Majidul Haque and State Minister for Religious Affairs Prof. Abdul Mannan also addressed the meeting as special guests.

Among others, BNP local leaders Babu Kartik Thakur, Mr. Maniruzzaman Manir and Kazi Golam Mahub addressed the meeting.

Mirza Golam Hafez said people of all strata fought for establishing Bangladesh national identity through struggle but we could not achieve economic emancipation as yet," he added. Keeping

this in view, the law minister said, we are to work hard to build a self-reliant nation.

Mirza Golam Hafez said the government had attached equal importance to the upliftment of all areas of the country as mentioned in the Constitution. He said the members of Talsil Shampradaya (scheduled caste) had been deprived of their rights during the last nine years of autocratic rule.

"On the other hand present government is firmly determined to preserve the rights of minority communities," he added. Agriculture Minister Majidul Haque called upon the local people irrespective of caste and affiliation to participate in the canal digging programme on self-help basis for its successful implementation. He said that government was aware of the problems of Talsil people which would be solved with due importance.

Compulsory primary education from Jan 1

The government has decided to make the primary education compulsory all over the country in phases, and in the first phase, 64 upazilas will be brought under the programme from the coming academic year beginning on January 1 (one) next year, reports BSS.

According to a recent gazette notification, the Primary Education (Compulsory) Act 1990, will be in force from January 1, 1992 in 4 (four) upazilas — Savar in Dhaka district, Patiya in Chittagong district, Puthia in Rajshahi district and Phultala in Khulna district and the Sadar upazilas of remaining 60 (sixty) districts.

The Education Ministry is now busy with the preparations for the implementation of the programme through mobilization of the people in these 64 upazilas for sending their wards belonging to the age group of 6-9 years to the primary schools in their respective areas.

The guardians will also be persuaded to ensure regular attendance by their children in the schools till the end of the 5-year term of primary education.

The compulsory primary education committees at ward and union levels in both rural and municipal areas will be formed to make the programme successful.

The district committees headed by the Deputy Commissioners and the upazila committees led by Upazila Nirbahi Officers will also be formed to supervise and implement the compulsory primary education programme.

Chhatra Oikya Forum held a rally in front of National Press Club demanding release of its leader Moshrefa Mishu and Javed Iqbal Khan.

Presided over by MA Awal the rally was addressed, among others, by Badrul Alam, Mohiuddin Labu and Shadiul Islam.

The Forum announced a nationwide agitation programme on Tuesday, torch procession on December 27, and a day-long token hunger strike on December 31.

Mishu, convener of the Forum was arrested December 16 on charge of dacoity.
