In reply to a question, he (Repeal) Bill has been con- said there are two procedures in repealing the ordinance. promulgated on September 26, 1975. The ordinance itself can be repealed by simple majority in the House, or the relevant parts (indemnity parts) of the 5th Amendment to the Constitution can be amended by a two-thirds majority.

The Awami League leader said the Indemnity Bill was moved in the house on August 8 on the basis of consensus and a special parliamentary committee constituted the same day to scrutinise the bill within a month.

He said Law Minister Mirza Golam Hafiz, Deputy Leader of the House Prof Badruddoza Chowdhury and leaders of other opposition groups had spoken in favour of the bill at that time.

Recalling the Law Minister's categorical assurance, Samad hoped the government party would play a positive role in rescinding the ordinance to give the hard-won democracy an institutional shape and ensure rule of law in the country.
