

MOSCOW, Jan 5 : Russia is to end the state monopoly in mining gold and other precious metals and stones, but still objects to foreign capital and know-how in mining development, the administrator of a key gold producing region said, reports Reuter.

Interfax news agency quoted Viktor Mikhailov, head of administration of the Magadan district, as saying that the Russian government planned to allow regions to give licences for prospecting and for developing precious

stones and metals. But the Russian government still objected to allowing foreign firms a stake in prospecting and in mine development,

Mikhailov said. According to Interfax, Mikhailov said a lack of hard currency and know-how on environmentally safe mining practices was handicapping
