Show tolerance to others' views, Khaleda tells JCD

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia said yesterday the present government had attached great importance to education and allocated the highest amount of money in that sector in the national budget, reports BSS.

"Education got the highest allocation in our budget since we want to spread education all over the country", she said when a delegation of students and teachers of Bangladesh Institute of Technology (BIT), Dhaka came to meet her at the Sugandha office.

The Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) won the recent Students Union election in the BIT, Dhaka.

Education Minister Jamrudin Sircar, State Minister for Religious Affairs Prof M A Mannan, Director of BIT Dr M Sekandar Ali and vice president and general secretary respectively of the BIT, Dhaka Central Students' Union Adnan Karim Majumdar and A K M, Zahurul Islam also spoke.

Referring to the introduction of compulsory primary education Begum Zia said that this was aimed at reaching education to all.

She said, to earn cheap popularity, the autocratic regime in the past had nationalised different educational institutions indiscriminately without providing necessary facilities.

Begum Zia called upon the students to maintain healthy and good relations with other student bodies saying, 'in democracy there may be differences of opinions but we have to show tolerance to others' views.'

She was happy to know there exists a very congenial atmosphere in the BIT and there is no wrangling on the wall or posters on the campus.

Referring to certain relevant problems, Begum Zia said the government would provide a transport for the BIT and would give due importance for construction of a hostel for the girl students.

The student leaders observed that victory of JCD in student union elections was a victory of the ideals of President Ziaur Rahman and the leadership of Begum Khaleda Zia.

Health policy

Meanwhile: The newly elected office-bearers of Bangladesh Medical Association Monday met Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia at her office.

Begum Zia said the present government had already taken up several steps to improve the present condition of the medical community of the country.

Begum Zia also called upon the physicians to help the government formulate realistic and effective health and drug policies.

The newly elected President of BMA Prof M A Majed and Dr Gazi Abdul Huq spoke on the occasion. The leaders of physicians assured the Prime Minister to support and cooperate the present government in all its democratic steps.

Bangladesh Ainjibi Federation

The procession paraded Rajarbag Square, Dainik Bangla Square, Press Club and ended at Kakrail Square.

Janata Dal

Bangladesh Janata Dal chairman KM Obaidur Rahman on Monday said that the speech of the president in the fifth Parliament disappointed the people.

In a statement he said the history of the nation was not reflected in his speech and the contribution of the national leaders in the historic change-over was not acknowledged.

Moreover, he did not mention many national problems and issues, he said.

Bangladesh Diabetes Forecasting Centre organised a camp at Kalyanpur slums to detect diabetes patients on Monday.

A mobile camp of the centre led by its convener Aminul Huq Bhuiyan, tested nearly 50 people of the slum. Dr Akter Syed Ahmed of the Diabetes Hospital was also present at the camp.

CEC asks all to ensure free, fair UP polls

COX'S BAZAR, Jan 6: The Chief Election Commissioner, Justice Mohammad Abdur Rouf, today urged all concerned to ensure free, fair and peaceful elections of the union parishads for reflecting the real public opinion, reports BSS.

He was addressing two separate meetings of the officials of the government, semi-government, and autonomous organisations, law-enforcing agencies, political leaders, leading people of the localities and the candidates, at Moheshkhal and Cox's Bazar sadar upazilas.

Justice Rouf referred to large scale damage of properties due to violent activities during the last union parishad elections in the country and said repetition of such shameful acts would not be allowed under any circumstances this time. Stern action would be taken against any terrorist and illegal activities including exercise of muscle power and hooliganism, he stressed.

He made it clear that the Election Commission would declare null and void the election unhesitatingly if it was proved that rigging was done or illegal activities were re-

sorted to in any place. He said certain special steps would be taken to resist the propensity to influence the election results through intimidation and allurement.

The Chief Election Commissioner also exchange views with the senior officials, local elite and journalists at the Chittagong Circuit House today.

CHITTAGONG, Jan 6: Movement for Press Freedom (MPF) today expressed its solidarity with the journalists of Myanmar in their struggle for press freedom, reports BSS.


