Besides, Muslim League leader Quazi Quader, KSP leader A.S.M Solaiman, the Bangladesh Observer Editor Prof. K.M.A Munim, noted journalists Abul Hashem, Motahar Hossain Siddiqui, former Navy chief Rear Admiral M.H. Khan, former Foreign Secretary A H M Mursheed and Barister Shawkat were present.

Fixation of Tk 2000 as minimum wage demanded

The leaders of employees and workers at a press conference Sunday called for immediate implementation of their three-point charter of demands.

The demands include fixation of Taka 2000 as minimum wage, two festival bonuses and two and a half incentive bonuses a year, reinstatement of terminated employees, workers and implementation of ILO convention.

The leaders of the Federation of Employees and Workers of Government, Semi-Government, Non-Government and Autonomous Offices addressed the press conference at Hotel Pritom in the city.

Among the leaders, Sadakul Bari, Shamsul Huda, President and Secretary General of the Federation also addressed the press conference.

The sramik leaders said that employees and workers were carrying on movement for the establishment of their fundamental rights but the movement could not bring about any changes as some of the leaders of different sramik organizations being patronized by the government foil the movement every time.

The President of the Federation spoke against the policy of denationalisation and demanded to stop it immediately.

MIDAS training course concludes

MIDAS (Micro Industries Development Assistance Society) recently organized and conducted a 5-week training course on the Institutional Self-Sufficiency of NGOs in Bangladesh, says a press release.

Sponsored by The Asia Foundation, Dhaka, this training programme was first of its kind in Bangladesh. Seventeen executive committee members and project managers of 9 NGOs now being supported by The Asia Foundation in MCHFP (Maternal Child Health-Family Planning) and Legal Aid sectors, participated in the training programme.

This training course was the first component of a two-and-a-half-year programme for institutional self-sufficiency of NGOs. The training will be followed by a two-year follow-up on NGO activities aimed at taking up IGAs (income-generating activities) for attainment of institutional self-sufficiency.

The course was conducted at BASC (Business Advisory Services Centre), a project of MIDAS.

Mahmoodul Haq, Executive Director of MIDAS distributed certificates among the participants as the chief guest.

Anwarul Asim Syed, the Project Director of BASC, and Shahjahan Kabir, the Project Adviser of The Asia Foundation were present on the occasion.

Tk 200 cr subsidy given to Palli rationing a year

RAJSHAHI, Jan 19: Food Minister M Shamsul Islam today called upon to the food officials to put in their best efforts to make the current internal aman procurement drive a success with a view to ensuring fair price to the growers and building buffer food stock in the country, reports BSS.

The minister was presiding over a meeting of food officials of greater Rajshahi district at Moniruddin Akhand Auditorium here.

The Food Minister said

proper distribution of commodities under Palli Ration System should be ensured for the welfare of poor rural people. He said government was providing subsidy of over Taka 200 crore per year in Palli rationing system. He stressed the need for distributing Palli Ration commodities among the deserving people.

Islam said since food is the most essential commodity a better food management was indispensable. He said, every one was accountable under the

present democratic government. He cautioned that stern action would be taken against any corruption.

The minister asked the food officials to discharge their duties with sincerity, honesty and dedication for the well-being of the country.

The meeting was informed that so far 2 lakh 45 thousand 4 hundred metric tons of rice have been procured in Rajshahi division which is 61 per cent of the target for the division.
