

'Zia initiated multi-party democracy'

Minister for Social Welfare and Women's Affairs Tariqul Islam said in Dhaka on Monday the national efforts of eradicating illiteracy would be easier if literate persons take responsibility of teaching the illiterate persons, reports BSS.

2.15 lakh acres to be brought under Boro cultivation

CHITTAGONG, Jan 20: An extensive scheme has been undertaken to bring 215,000 acres under Boro cultivation in all 14 upazila and the metropolitan areas of the district during the current season, reports BSS.

According to Agriculture Extension Department here, a total of 30,000 acres was brought under vegetable farming in the season for which taka ten crore was sanctioned to facilitate advancing of necessary loans among the farmers of the district.

Meanwhile 93,200 kg of seeds HYV paddy was distributed among the farmers and they have already prepared

seedbeds, the source said.

The department in cooperation with Agriculture Development Corporation will distribute fertilizers, insecticides, power pump, tubewell and other necessary agricultural inputs for optimum production of the Boro crops.

The production target in the season has been estimated at 238,800 metric tons of rice.

4055 power lines severed: 20 held

In massive drives by four DESA Courts led and assisted by Chairman DESA, members DESA, four 1st class magistrates, engineers, workers and policemen at some areas under Uttara thana including Dakhhinkhan-Kachkura and Mirpur thana including Rupnagar and Sec. XII Block TAA 4 thousand 55 illegal power lines were severed and 20 illegal power users were taken into custody, says a press release. Fines amounting Tk 16 thousand were realised, 171 cases were filed and 11 maunds of illegal electric wires were seized during the drive.

2 Bangladeshi children earn distinction in Bhutan

Two Bangladeshi children have passed with distinction, one of them topping the list of successful students. In the nationally held annual competitive public examination, the class VIII common examinations, 1991, conducted by the Bhutan Board of Examinations last year, says a press release.



According to the results published by the board this week, Syed Nageeb Mustafa Ali, student of Yangchenphug High School, Thimphu, has stood first together with a Bhutanese boy, securing 75 per cent marks.

Nadira Sultana, also of Yangchenphug and two Bhutanese students have secured the third position, with per cent 72 per cent marks.

A total of eight students have been declared passed with distinction this year.

Land registration to be made easy

RAJSHAHI, Jan 20: Law and Justice Minister Mirza Golam Hafiz today said, the government would take step to make easy the Land Registration System through removing complexities, reports BSS.

He said, the regulations promulgated by the 'autocratic government' in case of land registration would be examined properly to lessen people's harassment.

He was addressing a meeting of deed writers here. The meeting was addressed, among others, by State Minister for Law and Justice Barrister Aminul Haque, Azizur Rahman MP, Luthfunnessa Hossain MP and Inspector General of Registration Siddiqui Rahman.
