## Tk 2500 cr plan for health facilities

RAJSHAHI, Jan 22: Health and Family Welfare Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yousuf today called upon the physicians to take pledge for serving the cause of mankind, reports BSS.

The minister was addressing the installation ceremony of newly elected working committee of BMA, Rajshahi Branch at Rajshahi Medical College here.

Presided over by Prof Kaiser Rahman Chowdhury, the function was addressed by State Minister for Land Kabir Hossain, Prof Abdul Kader, Principal of Rajshahi Medical College and Dr Syed Amjad Ali, General Secretary of BMA, Rajshahi Branch.

The Health Minister said the building of Rajshahi Dental College Hospital will be constructed and an ambulance for Rajshahi Medical College Hospital would be provided soon. The government will provide jobs to 250 unemployed physicians at the earliest, he said.

Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yousuf said the government had undertaken a massive health and population control programme of about Taka 2500 crore to ensure medical facilities to all. He said, it would not be possible for the government alone to imple-

ment the programme. Cooperation and assistance of all concern were needed in this regard, he added.

Recalling the physicians role in mass upsurge the health minister said they could contribute significantly to lessen people's sufferings. He also lauded the doctor's performance in cyclone-hit areas. Yousuf said, since the physicians belong to superior class of the society, people's expectation from them was much. Accountability in all spheres would be ensured by the present government, he added.

The Health Minister underscored the need for sincere work and good managerial capacity for running the medical institutions smoothly.

## SEBA to construct 900 houses for cyclone victims

Its voluntary works at the coastal area involve the down-trodden people with a view to alleviating poverty, generate income, control population, educate the masses, train up the people on rural uplift etc. of the 12,000 beneficiaries of

SEBA, most of whom are landless.

Recently, the organisation arranged two rallies at Sonagazi and Mirshawarai upazilas. About 8,000 landless people attended the rallies.

The Executive Director of SEBA, Imam Sharif spoke on the occasion.
