Livestock sector lagging behind due to lack of attention

Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman (Sunday) called for development of the livestock sector with a view to generating employment, alleviating poverty and expediting development, reports BSS.

Inaugurating a workshop on livestock research in Bangladesh at Bangladesh Livestock Research Institute (BLRI) at Savar the Finance Minister said this sector had the potential of being turned into a viable commercial sector in an agro-based country like Bangladesh.

State Minister for Fisheries, Livestock, Environment and Forest Goyeswar Chandra Roy attended the function, organised by the BLRI, as the special guest.

Presided over by BLRI Director Prof. Shamsul Huq, the inaugural function was also addressed by Niamatullah Sabu, MP and Fisheries and Livestock Secretary AZM Nasiruddin.

Dr. Jahangir Alam Khan, a Chief Scientific Officer of the BLRI, presented key-note paper on "The status of livestock sector in Bangladesh: implications for research" at the workshop.

The Finance Minister said, "our country has made significant development in the food crop sector and we are going to be self-sufficient in food soon."

However, the country is lagging behind in the livestock sector as due importance was not being given to the sector in the past, he said.

Saifur Rahman said side by side education and family planning sectors, the government attaches top priority to the agriculture sector that contributes 45 to 48 per cent of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP).
