Various organisations in separate statements Tuesday protested and condemned the statement of Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman regarding the demands of the employees of four nationalised commercial banks.

Bangladesh National Awami Party leaders Prof Mozaffar Ahmed and Pankaj Bhattacharya in a statement said the comments of the Finance Minister about the politicians who supported the movement of the bank employees were not only regretful but also objectionable.

Depicting a grim picture, she said law and order situation deteriorated sharply. People in general are suffering from a sense of insecurity. Murder, arrest and harassment of political opponents are the other of the day.

Resistance has to be organised against all such atrocities of the ruling party and public opinion should be mobilised, she emphasised.
