Noman, Zaki talk strategy to tackle environmental disasters

Visiting SAARC Secretary General Ibrahim Hossain Zaki called on Minister for Forest and Environment Abdullah Al Noman at his office Tuesday, reports UNB.

They discussed a common strategy of the member countries to tackle environmental disasters in the region.

Environment is one of the 12 areas of cooperation the seven-nation forum has so far identified.

Reduce dependence on foreign aid: Nizami

Jammal-e-Islami leader Maulana Mattur Rahman Nizami said at the Jatiya Sangsad Tuesday that democracy and terrorism could not exist together, reports BSS.

Participating in the general discussion on the President's address to parliament, the leader of Jamaat Parliamentary Party demanded that the future national polls should be held under caretaker government so that none could bring allegations of rigging against others.

Maulana Nizami stressed the need for reducing dependence on external help and NGOs. He said checking erosion of moral values and corruption was essential to consolidate democracy.

The Jamaat leader said 'all of us should play our due role to give democracy a firm shape.' Referring to the President's speech, he said the President had due place in the constitution but wanted to know whether he was getting due coverage in the electronic media.

Referring to the acts of terrorism witnessed by the society in the recent days, he said law itself was not enough, its due implementation was also needed. He strongly pleaded for separation of the judiciary from the executive to ensure independence of judiciary.



The Civil Aviation delegation of Turkey and Bangladesh held talks at Civil Aviation Bhaban at ZIA, Tuesday to finalise the air services agreement between the two countries. The five-member Turkish delegation was led by Yildirim Saldiraner, Deputy Director General, Civil Aviation, Ministry of Communications while Air Commodore Azharul Haq, Chairman, Civil Aviation Authority of Bangladesh, led the Bangladesh side.

PM seeks cooperation to revitalise economy

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia Tuesday called upon the workers and employees to take a renewed pledge to increase production in fields and factories with a view to achieving the cherished goal of self-reliance in the country, reports BSS.

"Let us take a pledge on this auspicious month of February to increase production in all spheres of national life to attain self-reliance," she said at a meeting of the Bangladesh Water Development Board Jatiyatabadi Sramik Karmachari Union at WAPDA premises here.

She said the country's economic condition had been ruined during the autocratic regime and it must be brought to the right track through increasing production. "You have reposed a great trust on the present BNP government by voting it to power," she said adding "now you have to cooperate with the government in implementing its various programmes for the welfare of the people."

Presided over by union president Nimal Pad Singha Roy the meeting was also addressed, among others, by State Minister for Youths and Sports Sadek Hossain, president and general secretary respectively of Jatiyatabadi Sramik Dal Iskandar Ali and Nazrul Islam Khan, union general secretary Abul Kashem Chowdhury and Sramik leader A K M Nazrul Islam.

The Prime Minister sought cooperation of all in revitalising the country's economy and

said the government had already taken up some steps in this regard.

She referred to the various odds under which the new government had to set sail and added it had to tackle the worst-ever cyclone and three consecutive floods.

Begum Zia called upon the workers and employees to maintain discipline and harmony in the industrial sector so that foreign investors could invest in setting up industries in Bangladesh. She said the vast unemployed people could be absorbed in the mills and factories if those were set up in large numbers.

Referring to the demands of the employees and workers, the Prime Minister said all their genuine demands would be met in phases provided the economy permitted the government to do so. "The economy will take wings if production increases in the mills and factories," she added.

She said "development had taken place during the tenure of past BNP government only and thereafter no development had taken place in the country." There is no time to look back, she said adding we must work from now on to take the country to the path of progress and prosperity.

The Prime Minister called upon the employees and workers to look after the interest of the commonman and help maintain price stability in the country by increasing production.

She said the BNP had emerged from among the

common people and its prime objective was to look after their interests.

Begum Zia stressed the need for avoiding use of foreign goods for the interest of local industries and said smuggling could not be stopped only by engaging police and BDR forces. "You should have to remain alert against smuggling," she added.

Referring to the vast women working force, the Prime Minister said they were contributing greatly for the development of the country. She said the government had taken up special programmes for the women.

Begum Zia assured them that the workers and employees who were terminated illegally during the autocratic regime would be given back jobs. She said a committee had been formed to look into the matter.
