Tk 17.16 cr Japanese grant for development of fisheries sector

Bangladesh will receive a grant of 652 million yen (about Taka 17.16 crore) from Japan under an exchange of notes signed in Dhaka Monday for the overall development of fisheries sector, reports BSS.

The fund is being made available under Japanese economic cooperation to Bangladesh for the project titled "Establishment of Fish Landing Preservation and Distribution Facilities" at Monoharkhal. The money will be utilised through Bangladesh Fisheries Development Corporation (BFDC) in two phases.

In the first phase of implementation of the project, a floating pontoon and a wharf will be constructed for improvement of fish landing and

distribution facilities. Construction of wholesale fish market, ice-making plant and cold storage for improvement of marketing and preservation of fish are there in the second phase of the project, a press release of the Japanese embassy said. It computed that the grant amount to approximately Taka 20 crore.

An official handout said the objective of the project is to improve the landing, preservation and distribution of fishes caught by mechanised and local fishing boats for supply of those to Dhaka, Chittagong and other places. It will also help prevent deterioration of fish caught through speedy distribution and marketing.

Iranian Red Crescent to help Rohingyas

The Red Crescent Society of the Islamic Republic of Iran would provide all possible assistance to the Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) for its relief programme for the Myanmar refugees in Cox's Bazar and Bandarban districts, reports BSS.

The assurance came from the President of the Iranian Red Crescent Society Wahid Deastjerdi, during his meeting with the Chairman of the Bangladesh Red Crescent Society, Syed Shahidul Huq Jamal.

Wahid Deastjerdi who is leading a two-member delegation of his Society to Bangladesh to express its sense of affinity with the BDRCS which has been engaged in a giant relief operation for a "man-made disaster" said that the assistance of his society would be in the form of cash and kind.

We would assess the requirement of the BDRCS for

the relief operation and decide the form of materials needed to meet this exigency, Deastjerdi added.

The Chairman of the BDRCS said that immediate need for the refugees were some kind of shelter to hide their head, and food and clothing. He said that the unpredictability of such kind of tragedy on such a large number of people had not only caught the BDRCS unaware but also thrown it into quandary.

"We know not how to face such situation in such a short notice", he said and added that the immediate need of the Society was CI sheet, tent, blankets and foodstuff.

Wahid Deastjerdi assured him that these materials could be mobilised by the Iranian Red Crescent Society.

Earlier on arrival Wahid Deastjerdi was received at the airport by the Chairman of the BDRCS Syed Shahidul Huq Jamal.
