CAB for effective transport policy

Consumers' Association of Bangladesh Wednesday urged for an effective transport policy to ease the sufferings of the bus passengers, reports UNB. At a meeting in Azampur

High School premises in the city on Tuesday, they said the bus passengers were subjected to different types of harassment in spite of paying higher fare.

The services rendered by the buses are far below required standard, they added. They said, "The passengers are held hostages at the hand of transport authorities whenever they move in buses, minibuses and other transports".

BUET Festival '92 inaugurated Saboteurs creating session jam to cripple nation: Huda

Information Minister Najmul Huda Wednesday called upon students and others to unitedly resist terrorism, reports BSS.

Inaugurating the four-day Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) Festival-92 here, the minister said conspirators were behind acts of campus violence to destroy the country's education sector.

He said the conspirators were active so that there could not grow skilled manpower like doctors, engineers and technocrats in the country. He said the saboteurs were creating session jams to cripple the nation.

Huda said it was the collective responsibility of all to work for economic emancipation of the people in the present democratic system. He sought cooperation of all to help build self-reliant Bangladesh.

The minister stressed the need for consolidating the present democratic atmosphere by foiling any attempt to disrupt the process.

Praising the glorious role of students in the anti-autocratic movement, he urged the students to work in the same spirit as they did in the democratic movement.

He praised the role of students, teachers and employees for freeing BUET from the influence of terrorists.

Dr M Shahjahan, Vice Chancellor of BUET, Prof Nazrul Islam, Prof A B M Siddique Hossain and Meer Ruhul Kabir and Kazi Fazlur Karim, Vice

President and General Secretary respectively of Central Students Union also spoke.

Dr Shahjahan said BUET will foil any attempt by the outsiders to create violence in the same spirit of unity as it did in the past. He stressed the need for frequent interactions between teachers and students to maintain a healthy and congenial academic atmosphere.

Later, the Information Minister inaugurated the four-day exhibition organised by the Faculty of Architecture and Planning.

Some locally manufactured building materials, fixtures and fittings are on display in the exhibition.

The two-day computer exhibition will begin today.
