

Coldstorage demanded

Tk 60cr mango, vegetables Perish every year

CHAPAINAWABGANJ, Feb 28: About 40 per cent of different products like mangoes, fishes, tomatoes and other vegetables worth crores of taka are perished every year in the district for want of coldstorage.

source, 73,100 tons of mango worth around Taka 100 crore, 3952 tons of fish worth about Taka 36 crore, 400 tons of tomato worth about Taka 40 lakh and about 23 lakh tons of vegetables like cabbage, potato, brinjal and lemon worth over several lakhs taka are produced in the district. Apart from this, large number of eggs are available here which are transported to other places of the country including Dhaka.

As the above mentioned goods are perishable, the growers are compelled to sell these to the brokers at a very lower price. So, the growers are deprived of the fair prices of the commodities.

According to Agricultural Extension Department, the prospect for potato cultivation in the district is bright but due to the want of coldstorage facility, the farmers are not interested to cultivate the same.

The stoppage of transport movement by frequent hartal and strike calls causes huge losses to the perishable goods of this district.

An official of the local Agricultural Extension Department said that the concerned authority had planned to set up a coldstorage of 10,000 metric tons capacity and accordingly an approximate estimation was forwarded to the higher authority for approval. But nothing has been done as yet for the reasons not known.

The farmers of the Chapainawabganj district are eagerly waiting for a coldstorage as they will be able to avoid huge losses. The conscious circle thinks that if a coldstorage is set up here, the agricultural production of the district will be soaring up to a great extent.

The employees continued to observe two-hour token strike from Tuesday in support of the call of Bangladesh Pura Karmochari Federation for pay rise.

They will observe a half-day pen down strike on March 2. It is learnt.

45 hurt in post-polls clash, 4 including Chairman held

JESSORE, Feb 28: At least 45 persons were injured in a clash between the supporters of two chairman candidates of the last union parishad election of Jadabpur under Moheshpur upazila in Jhendah recently.

The supporters of Rabtul Islam, a defeated chairman candidate suddenly attacked the supporters of Shahidul Islam, elected Chairman of the UP without any provocation and assaulted them mercilessly.

The supporters of the

elected Chairman got furious at this and made a counter attack on the rival group which left many injured.

The injured persons of Rabtul Islam's party were admitted to the Moheshpur Upazila Health Complex. A case has been registered with the local thana under Section 14 dated 20-2-92 while the injured persons of Chairman's party were released after first aid and the police also refused to register any case in this connection.

The Chairman shifted the injured persons of his party of Chougacha Upazila Health Complex. It is informed.

Later, the police arrested the Chairman and three other supporters named Sohrab Hossain, Amrul Islam and Yousuf Ali in connection with the case filed by Rabtul Islam's party. The upazila court rejected the petitions for bail.

It can be mentioned here that backed by ruling party, Rabtul Islam and his supporters are engaged in unruly and aggressive activities. They have created a reign of terror in the area. The chairman is a supporter of opposition party.

Miscreants kill 2 at Kushtia town

KUSHTIA, Feb 28: A young man was brutally killed in broad day light by a group of armed assailants on Thursday, reports UNB.

Police sources said, Murshed (24), owner of MN Video, Majampur Raitgate of the town, was attacked by 6 assailants while he was sitting in his shop at about 11-30 am.

The miscreants suddenly attacked the victim with a knife, Chinese axe and other sharp weapons causing multiple injuries on his body. He died on the spot.

The place of incident is only 100 feet away from Majampur Traffic Island where two sergeants and three constables were present during the incident.

Superintendent of Police visited the spot and told this correspondent that this murder could be the sequel to an earlier clash that ensued between the brother of the victim, Nazam and a political party.

Nazam was one of the accused in a case filed in this connection and he is still absconding.

In another incident one Mirazul Islam, 25, son of Azfar Rahman Mir of Jhalupara was killed by unknown miscreants while he was sleeping at a rice mill near the town Wednesday night.

The cause of murder was not known immediately. His body was sent to hospital for autopsy. A case has been filed with the police.

Gambling rampant
Another report says: Police seized 165 pieces of Indian sares, 185 bottles of Phenidyl

syrup and 2 kgs of ganja worth about Taka 50,000 from a Dhaka bound coach of Bidyut Paribahan which was coming from Daulatpur on Monday.

The contrabands were later handed over to the customs authorities and a case has been filed in this connection.

Another report from Poradai adds: gambling-sprees inside the Jatra pandal here whipped up anti-social activities like theft, hijacking and dacoity in different areas of the upazila.

Local leaders have urged the authorities to stop anti-social activities in the name of Jatra.

House set on fire: baby killed, 3 injured

BRAHMANBARIA, Feb 28: A baby was killed and 3 others were injured when their house at Bidhakut village in Nabiganj upazila was set on fire by miscreants recently, reports UNB.

According to a report, one Harmuj Ali of the village took Taka 100 as loan from his neighbour Shaheed Mia. He failed to repay the loan even after repeated warnings.

On February 14, Shaheed Mia gave the final warning but the defaulter could not manage the sum. At this, Shaheed became furious and allegedly set his house on fire at midnight with the help of miscreants.

As a result, Harmuj Ali, 35, his wife Abeda Khatun, 28, daughter Shahara Khatun, 5, and son Akbar Hossain, 2, received serious injuries.

6 killed, 50 hurt in road mishap

GAIBANDHA, Feb 28: At least six people were killed on the spot and 50 others injured in a road accident on Dhaka-Rangpur Highway near Maheshpur in Palashbari upazila, two miles off here Wednesday noon, reports UNB.

Witnesses said the accident occurred when the driver of the Rangpur bound passenger bus lost control and fell into a road-side ditch. It was trying to bypass a truck on the highway.

Students ransack biddut office for frequent power failure

DINAJPUR, Feb 28: The local Pali Biddut Samity Office was ransacked Tuesday night by some students angered at frequent load-shedding at their college campus, reports UNB.

Official sources said the students of Hajl Danesh Agricultural College forcibly entered the office of the samity at about 8 pm on the day and ransacked the office furniture and tried to set fire on a vehicle.

The armed guard at the office fired a gun shot to disperse the mob. At about 9 pm the students seized a tractor of the samity and took it to the college campus.

Works on 640 TRP plans complete in Rajbari

RAJBARI, Feb 28: The works on 640 projects have been completed in four upazilas of the district under the Test Relief Programme (TRP).

A total of 1010 metric tons of wheat has been utilised for the implementation of the projects under the programme.

According to an official source, 329 metric tons of wheat were utilised for completion of 233 projects in sadar upazila, 44 metric tons for 25 projects in pourashava area, 164 metric tons for 106 projects in Baliakandi, 227 metric tons for 126 projects in Pangsha and the rest 246 metric tons of wheat were used for 147 projects in Goulundo upazila.

Besides, earth work of 17 kancha roads in three upazilas has been completed utilising 113 metric tons of wheat.

Of the total projects, 8 have been completed in Goulundo, 5 in Baliakandi, and 4 in sadar upazilas under

post-monsoon rehabilitation programme.

The works on construction of five roads are going on in full swing to complete within the current financial year under the Annual Development Programme.

The works on the roads will be completed by May next. With the completion of the roads, the communication of the district will greatly be improved.

An earlier report says: Shamsul Islam Khan, Food Minister paid a surprise visit to the local aman procurement centres to see the progress of the on-going aman procurement drive. He was accompanied by the State Minister for Lands, Kabir Hossain during his visit.

The Minister directed the Food officials to procure good quality of foodgrains according to the government directives.

A total of 2.85 lakh tons of rice have so far been procured at a cost of Taka 288 crore.

Cement supply short, price up

DINAJPUR, Feb 28: Sudden rise in the price of cement is affecting the construction sector in the district for the last one month, reports UNB.

Informed sources said the price rise was triggered by short supply of cement in the local market.

TCB dealers said they were getting much less than their normal quota due to poor stock of cement. Private traders and shopkeepers at Maldahpatty and the Station Road were also getting a reduced quota from

two government-owned cement factories at Sylhet and Chittagong due to low production.

The price of a bag of cement in the open market is now ranging from Taka 245 to 260. The price of TCB cement per bag is Taka 245.

Concerned TCB officials told UNB that the corporation has restricted issuing increased quota of cement to its dealers due to temporary shortfall in stock.
