Bangladesh still deserves food aid:IFPRI DG

Dr Just Faaland, the visiting Director-General of the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI). Saturday expressed optimism about Bangladesh's food selfsufficiency saying that food deficit was being reduced rapidly as the country made a tremendous progress in food production, reports BSS.

Addressing a press conference at IFPRI's office at Dhanmondi in the city residential area Dr Faaland, who was in Bangladesh as World Banks chief of mission during 1972-74 and Director of the Independent Agriculture Sector Review during 1987-88, said he found a persistent improvement in the country's food production.

Quoting research findings of the Institute, the Director-General said Bangladesh had proved to be a pessimistic countries so far the food production, particularly the rice was concerned. But he mentioned that the country was still lagging behind in wheat production.

He believed that the country would mark a rapid progress within next decade

But Dr Faaland felt the need for continued food aid to Bangladesh saying that the country still deserved food aid to supplement its development

He said the production of wheat was far less than the production of rice and if the wheat sector was given priority the production of both the two principal food items would risc proportionately.

Dr Faaland said the IFPRI had been working since 1975 aimed at identifying and analysing alternative national and international strategies for improving the food situation of the low-income countries and peoples of the world.

Elaborating a number of rescarches on Bangladesh food situation, he said that his Institute was only forwarding the findings of the research works suggesting improvement in the conditions of the food management.

He, however, refuted the allegation of a section of the press that the government had

He said the Institute has not imposed any decision so far. Dr Faaland explained that the research found out that the rationing system had proved to be an ineffective system and there was substantial leakage

The IFPRI Director General also felt that instead of rationing system which could not reach its benefits to the poor, the useful alternative to the system should be the food for work programme.

So far, the IFPRI has com pleted several researches with the help of Bangladesh Institute of Development Studies (BIDS) and a few others is being presently conducted. It has also provided technological assistance.

The IFPRI is currently implenienting a project advising the government of medium and long term food policy is sucs of Bangladesh. It is also carrying out a project on food policy of Hangladesh in collaboration with the Ministry of
