Upon a Writ petition filed by Faizul Haque Khan, Secretary, and four other Executive Committees of Gazipur Unit of Bangladesh Red Crescent Society, a Division Bench of the High Court Division of Bangladesh Supreme Court comprising Mr Justice F II Md Habibur Rahman and Mr Justice K M Hassan issued a Rule Nisi upon the respondents, the Chairman, Managing Board and others to show cause as to why the order dated February 10, 92 purporting to supersede the Executive Committee, Gazipur Unit of the Bangladesh Red Crescent Society and to appoint an Adhoc Executive Committee should not be declared to have been made without lawful authority and to be of no legal effect.

Both the parties have been directed to maintain Statusquo with regard to the running of the Executive Committee of Gazipur unit.

The Rule is made returnable within six weeks.

Claim on drum factory land
