### Khaleda visits fire-ravaged areas

## Death toll rises to 11

Six more bodies were recovered from the fire-ravaged area at Posta, Islambagh, in the city Tuesday and death toll rose to 11.

Of the six bodies, a three and a half years old girl was identified as Secma while the other five in which three were children and one was a 25-year-old woman and a 25-year-old man, were not identified, Lalbag police said.

The fire broke out from a thatched house in the slum and soon engulfed the adjacent dwelling houses. Fire fighters extinguished the fire after one and a half hours.

BSS adds: Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia Tuesday visited the fire-ravaged Posta area of Islambagh to see the extent of damage.

Begum Zia went round the devastated areas and talked to the affected people. She told them that the government would ensure all possible help and cooperation to mitigate their sufferings.

She called upon them to face the situation with courage and fortitude. The Prime Minister distributed relief among the affected people.

Dhaka City Corporation Mayor Mirza Abbas, State Minister for Relief Lutfar Rahman Khan, Red Crescent Chairman Syed Shahidul Haq Jamal MP, Farida Hasan MP and Local MP Mir Shawkat Ali accompanied the Prime Minister.

Meanwhile, the Relief Ministry sanctioned Taka two lakh and distributed 250 saris and 200 lungies among the fire affected people.

Red Crescent Society also undertake emergency relief operation in the area which was engulfed by a devastating fire Monday afternoon.

Meanwhile, Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) Tuesday began relief operation among the people affected by the devastating fire in Posta-Islambagh slum area in the city.

The relief goods being distributed among the affected people include rice, dal (pulse), edible oil, saris, lungies, children's garments and utensils.

### Queen's message on C'wealth Day

In a message on the occasion of the Commonwealth Day Queen Elizabeth II, head of the Commonwealth, asked the young people of the Commonwealth to make themselves aware of the crucial environmental problems and issues facing the member-states, reports UNB.

"There is no time to spare, it is your future that is at stake", the Queen said, urging all to share the task of ensuring that "our world will remain fit for life and capable of sustaining us and those who will come after us".

Referring to ensuring United Nations Conference on Environment and Development, the Queen also urged all for chalking out measures that will check further destruction and permanent degradation of world's natural resources.

"Unless we take action now to halt the rise in global temperatures, rising sea levels will threaten the very existence of several islands and low-lying Commonwealth countries," she warned.

Describing the Commonwealth as "a cross-section of the contemporary world" where one-third population of the world live, Queen Elizabeth stressed the need for democratic government for ensuring the future health and vitality of the natural world around us.

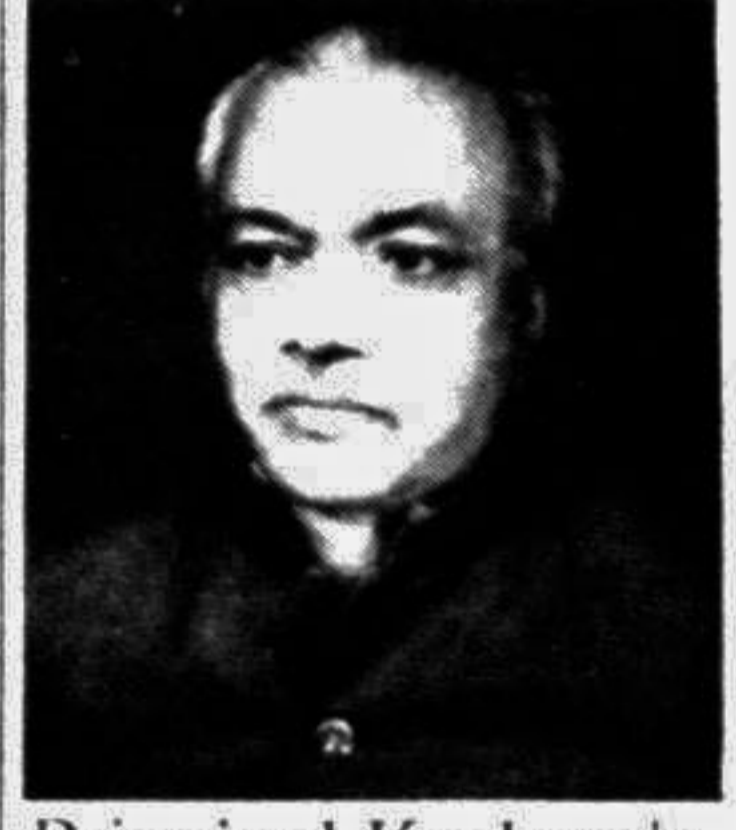
They also urged the government to repeal this agreement.

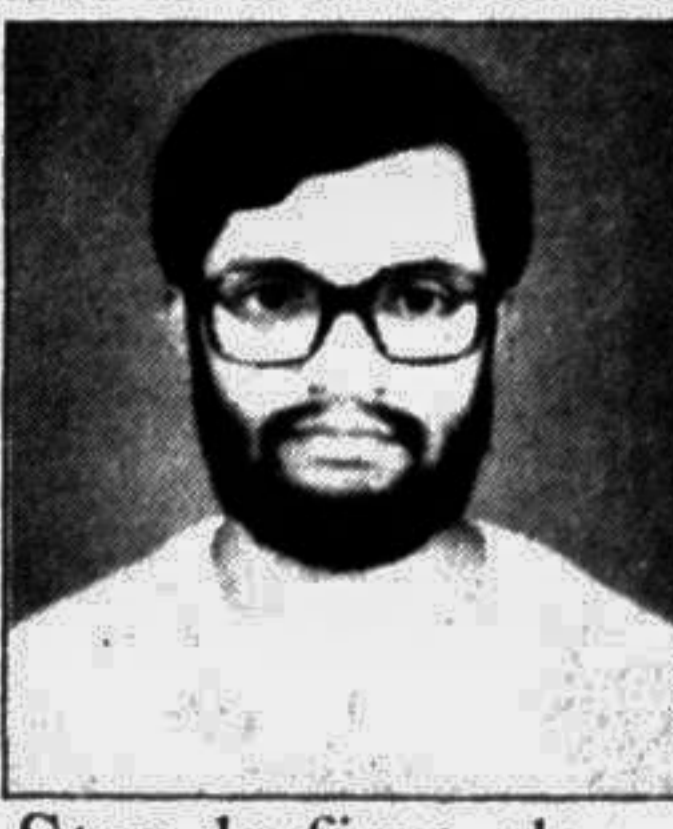
