The meeting, earlier scheduled for March 16, was called off due to Japan's reported reluctance to attend it.

Japan has long been hinting that it would provide 150 million US dollars for the 428-million dollar JMB project but suddenly turned cold in the wake of Bangladesh's hesitation in accepting the controversial KAFCO project.

Bangladesh has requested the World Bank - the organiser of the proposed April 26 meet - to complete all preparatory works by then for floating tenders shortly after the financing issue is confirmed.
