The memorandum, handed over to pro-VC Atul Hye Shibli, also demanded reopening of all postponed examinations without delay. Yasser Arafat Pitu, a leader of Bangladesh Chhatra League (N-S) and activist of Ganatantrik Chhatra Oikya, was shot dead on the university campus last Tuesday. GCO also called for ensuring necessary medicare for the students injured in the March 17 campus violence.

He left behind his wife, three sons, one daughter and a host of relatives and well wishers to mourn his death. His body will be flown in Dhaka the next available flight.

Special launch, steamer service during Eid

Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority has arranged special launch services during the ensuing Eid-ul-Fitr, reports BSS. The launches will operate during March 31 to April 10 from Dhaka to Bhola, Barisal, Bandura, Barguna, Chandpur, Ichuli, Madaripur, Sureswar, Torkey and Borhanuddin. From Narayanganj to Chandpur, Munsiganj, Taltala, Ramchandrapur, Machuakhali, Sureswar, Torkey and Motlab-Danga and from Narshingdhi to Nabinagar. The travelling passengers have been requested not to board the launches beyond carrying capacity. The owners, the masters, the serangs and all concerned have been advised to refrain from over-loading. They have been requested to follow the weather signal while operating the launches in the best interest of safety of the lives and the property and to take special care of safety according to legal requirements. Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Corporation (BIWTC) has arranged special steamer service for the convenient movement of passengers on the occasion of the Eid-ul-Fitr.

GP condoles school boy's death

Raise resources by 10 pc, Saifur tells tax officials

Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman Saturday exhorted the tax officials to raise the collection of internal resources by 10 per cent against the target set in the current budget, reports BSS. "To survive as a self-sustaining nation we have no other alternative than to increasing our own internal resources," he told high level tax officials of Chittagong division at National Economic Council Committee Room-1 here. Saifur Rahman took stock of the total tax collection position of different circles in Chittagong. He pointed out lapses in certain areas and directed the concerned officials to rectify them immediately and help earn more revenue. The Finance Minister asked the tax officials to prepare a comprehensive list of the big-trading houses and intensify inspection and supervision to reactivate the progress of tax collection. He said the tax officials will have to increase efficiency and determination to reduce tax evasion. He cautioned that any negligence in discharging duty will be severely dealt with.

2 railway employees arrested

Five persons including two railway employees were arrested by the security personnel for alleged pilferage of diesel from train engines, reports BSS. Railway authority also put two employees under suspension for their alleged links in the diesel pilferage. Railway security personnel this morning arrested three persons including Anup member when they were pilfering diesel from a passenger train at Nandail road station near Kishoreganj. Driver and assistant driver of the engine Abdul Jalil and Khurshid Mia were put under suspension for their alleged collaboration. In another incident the west zone railway security personnel arrested a goods train driver and assistant driver at Khulna Junction yard on March 18 when they were pilfering diesel from the engine.
